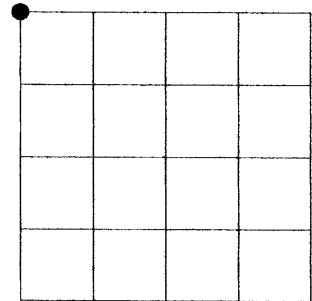

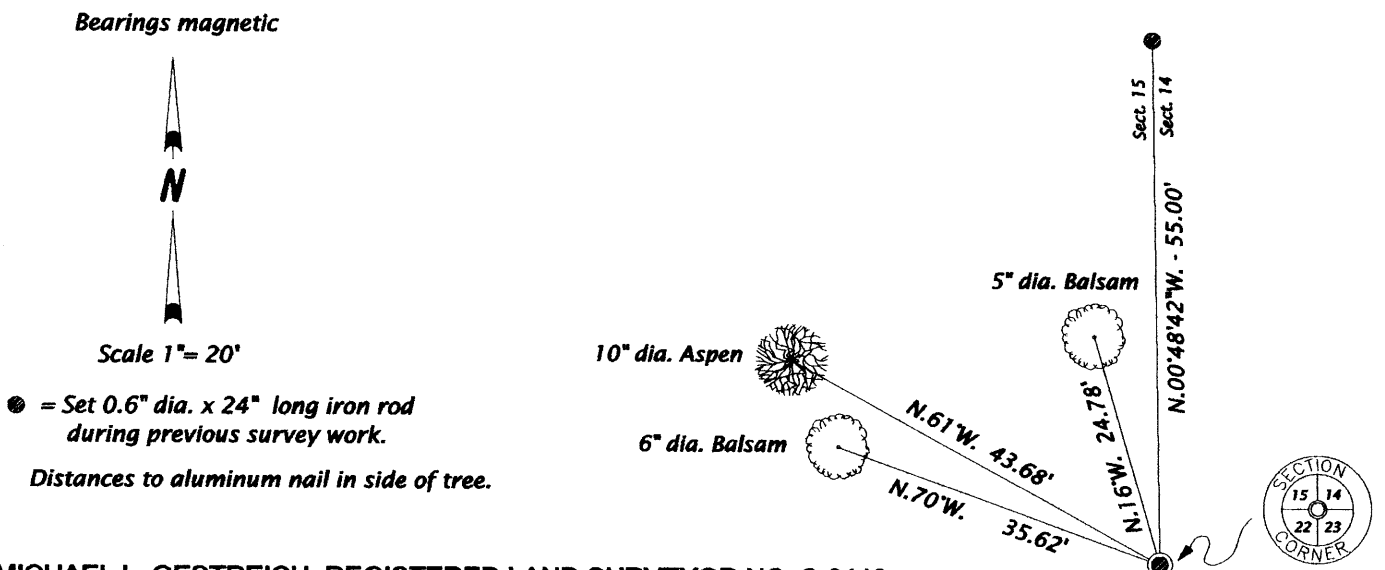

Michael L. Oestreich: 1/30/06, Found and accepted monument as indicated in previous monument record by Stefan and used said monument for survey work in Sections 14 and 23. Only the southwest bearing tree noted by Stefan still is standing, now a dead 5" dia. black ash that bears S18°W 46.01'. The northwest, northeast and southeast bearing tree remains are present. I made new witness ties as shown in the plan below.
