



  - Vern Maine found old stake and stumps of original BTs. He placed a  $2^{\text{"}}$  x  $60^{\text{"}}$ 7/9/1937 iron pipe - no new BTs and ran line North, along fence.
  - 8/27/1995 Milo E. Stefan found Maine's monument in good condition, tied it off with four new BTs and placed plastic sign post.
