## CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment

State of Wisconsin

Corner recovered and restored by D.H. Vaughan, County Surveyor, in 1905. Set new post and marked NBT's, spruce 10", N4-1/2 $^{\circ}$ W, 47 lks. and spruce 7", N66-1/2E, 33 lks. Corner re-N720W, 40 1ks. covered by H.C. Lawrence, Registered Land Surveyor, in 1948. Found Vaughan's post and BT's Original corner established by Wm. E. Dougherty, Deputy Surveyor, in 1863 from which birch intact. Set new cedar post and marked NBT's - white birch 9", S12°E, 19 1ks. and spruce 8", 2 10" bears  $N81^{\circ}E$ , 32 lks. and tamarack 8" bears  $S80^{\circ}N$ , 16 lks.

Description of corner evidence found

Also a 2-1/2" iron pipe with brass cap scribed S28-1/4 S27 setting beside wooden post. Recovered Lawrence's 5" cedar post, squared and scribed 1/48 827, 1/48 828 in fair condition. Original BI's now decayed mounds.

Recovered OBT's - White birch 9" (10") B. spruce 8"  $S12^{c}E$  $N72^{\circ}W$ 19 1ks. 40 1ks. now down and dead scribed 1/4 S27 NBT

Stamped brass cap with T36N, R10E and left it in place. Pipe and NBT's painted blue. NBT's - B. spruce 6" Calls to BT's fit the iron pipe more accurately than to the wooden post. Pipe projects 18" above ground. Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.
