





This is a perpetuation of a previous USPLS Monument Record by Philip T. Hansen, RLS dated June 30, 1977 and filed in the office of the Oneida County Register of Deeds. A complete history of the corner can be found on the previous monument record. I accept the previous location as a true and faithful perpetuation or reestablishment of the original corner location and further perpetuate it as follows.

August 21, 2018: I found and accepted the record monument, a 2-1/2" diam. iron pipe with a 4" sq. RIPCO brass plate projecting 16" above the ground surface. I found no evidence of the record black spruce. I found or established accessories as shown below. I set a white vinyl sign post bearing South, 1.5 ft.

The coordinate value shown has been verified by at least one of the following methods: 1) comparison to a previously CPS determined published value; 2) the value is the average of two or more GPS observations at a markedly different time; 3) one or more distances were measured back to the GPS observed corner from temporary GPS observed offset locations.
