

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment: Original survey established by Wm. E. Dougherty, Deputy Surveyor in 1859, from which fir 8" bears S21°E, 8 lks. and fir 7" bears N22°W, 10 lks. Corner recovered by B.F. Dorr, County Surveyor in 1906. Set new post and established NBT's - Tam. 22" S5°E, 27-1/4 lks. and Tam. 22" N28°W, 28 lks. 51 lks., elm 20 lks. N27°W, 106 lks., and boulder 7' x 4' high, S77°W, 33 lks. line at a point 227 lks. south of 1/4 corner. Recovered old BT's and fo nd the old stake Corner recovered by H.C. Lawrence, Registered Land Surveyor in 1948. He ran the E-W 1/4 lying flat on the ground. Set new tamarack post and made NBT's - spruce 12" N57°E, line west from C 1/4 corner of Section 22, and at 42.58 chains intersected the east



I referenced the corner as shown on the drawing on the reverse side.


