

Original corner established by Wm. E. Dougherty, Gov. Deputy Surveyor, in 1859, from which tamarack 10" bears S78°E 5 links, and aspen 10" bears S83°W 10 links.

He set new cedar post and made NBT - maple 9" S35°E 42 links.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered OBT's - sugar stump 17" S60°W 6.5 links - very decayed. Found chips with Recovered 4" tamarack post, squared and scribed \s S33, \s S34, in poor condition. scribe marks.

Red maple 9" (11") S35°E 42 links - scribing grown over.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Replaced  $4^{\prime\prime\prime}$  tamarack post with  $2\frac{1}{2}^{\prime\prime\prime}$  iron pipe with brass cap stamped -
