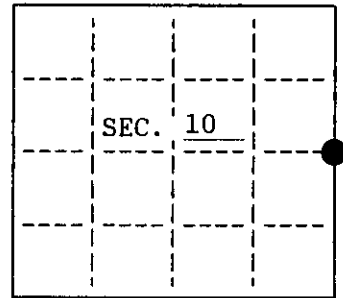

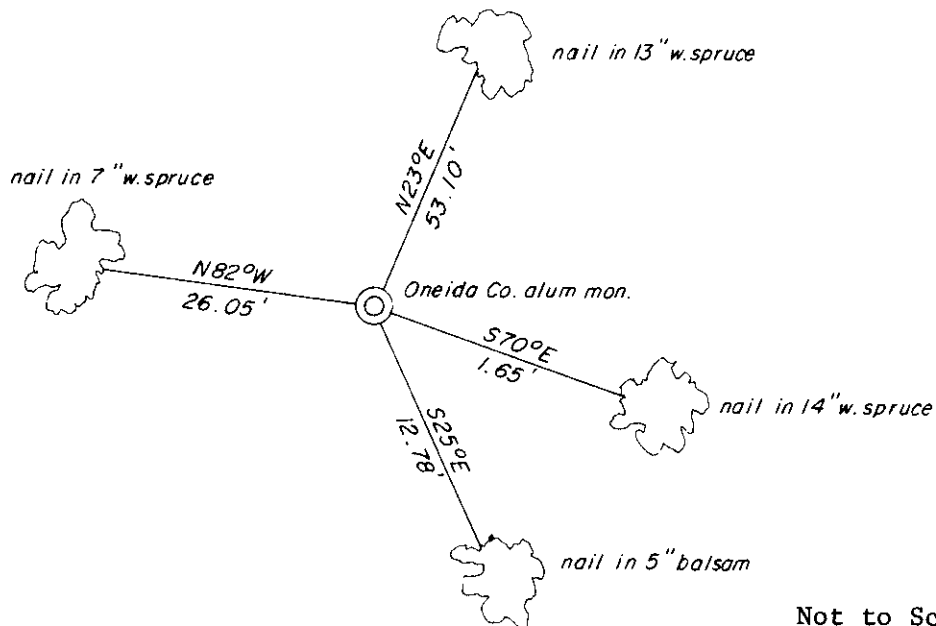

December, 1963 - Nekoosa Papers set a wood post by single proportion measure based on the incorrect location of the Southeast corner of Section 10.

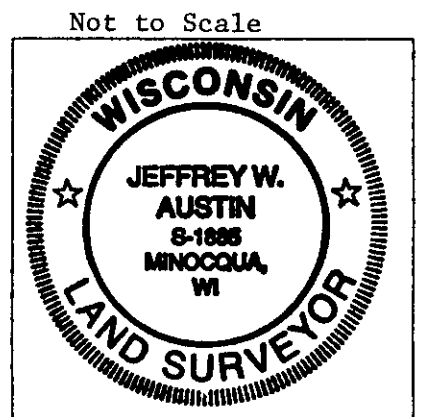
August 31, 1994 - I established this corner by single proportion measure between the original Northeast corner of Section 10 and the southerly bank of a 3-foot-wide creek on the line connecting the Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 10. The Northeast section corner bears N1°13'16"E, 2673.62 feet (GLO 40.00 ch.). The southerly bank of the creek bears S1°13'16"W, 925.74 feet (GLO 13.85 ch.). I monumented this location with a 2-1/2" x 30" Oneida County Aluminum Monument witnessed as shown below. I set a plastic signpost Southwest, 1.5 feet.

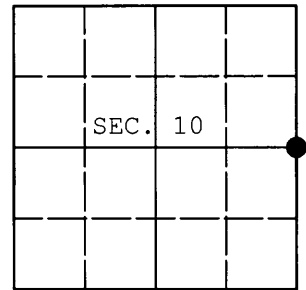

NOTE: This is a perpetuation of a previous USPLS Monument Record by Jeffrey W. Austin, RLS dated September 27, 1994 and filed in the office of the Oneida County Register of Deeds. A complete history of the corner can be found on the previous monument record. I accept the previous location as a true and faithful perpetuation or reestablishment of the original corner location and further perpetuate it as follows.

June 16, 2014: I found and accepted my previous 2.5" diam. Oneida County aluminum monument. My accessories were found in substantial agreement with the previous record and were not remeasured as the sole purpose of this work is to report the coordinates of the corner point.

The coordinates shown were derived from offset RTN GPS observations referenced to the WISCORS network.
