


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Sept. 1860 - Alfred Millard established this corner and set a wood post with two BTs:

10" Maple, S35°E, 19 Links (12.54')
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
- 6/2/1936 Vern Maine ran from Township Corner East and fell North of two stakes (Vaughans). He set a county monument and three BTs: 24" White Pine Stump, S55°W, 27 Links (17.82')
 4" Black Oak, S10°E, 13 1/4 Links (8.75')
 4" Black Oak, S80°E, 32 1/4 Links (21.28')
- 6/25/1996 Milo E. Stefan found Maines monument in good condition. We made new BTs and set a plastic sign post.
