History of original corner establishment:

July 17th, 1863 - WILLIAM E. DAUGHERTY, Deputy Surveyor set Wood Post, witnessed by Birch 8" N50°E, 26 lks (17.16 feet) and by a White Pine S40°W, 82 links (54.12 feet).

January 10th, 1893 - B. F. DORR, Oneida County Surveyor in Section 35 found N 1/4 P (Book No. 3 page 74).

August 19th, 1908 - D. H. VAUGHAN, Oneida County Surveyor in Section 35 found N 1/4 P (Book No. 6, page 42).

Description of corner evidence found:

Old corner post to good fence lines (mostly down) which run South and East, poor fence line mostly down North. Orig. White Pine Stump bears S20°W, 54 feet. Remains of rotten White Birch roots bear N50°E 17 feet. A 1" diameter iron pipe shown in several recent surveys as monumenting the quarter corner location bears N76°E, 15.77 feet.

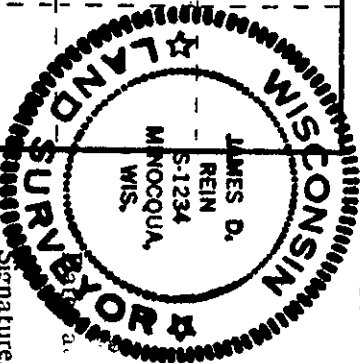
Note: Milo Stefan, Registered Land Surveyor and Forester with the U. S. Forest Service, identified the tree species of the White Pine Stump and remains of the White Birch roots.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Set in Oneida County Aluminum Berntsen Standard Monument 30" long, 24" in the ground to replace the Corner Post. Made bearing trees scribed "1/4 S B.T." with a P.K. nail set in lower face as follows:

- 8" Oak N29°E, 27.23 feet
- 15" Norway Pine N33°W, 86.68 feet
- 6" Red Maple, S79°W, 19.00 feet
