

- 01/16/1980 William E. Bandow OC Survey Map #B62 shows a symbol at the S 1/4 and indicates information from Dwg No. 4815 G&A.
- 10/01/2003 William E. Bandow OC Survey Map #B5372 found aluminum monument.
- 03/04/2021 I found and accepted an Oneida County aluminum monument 18" above grade at the corner location and witnessed the corner as shown below.
