


History of original corner establishment:

from which birch 14" bears N60°W 15 links and sugar 18" bears S43°E 20 links. Original corner established by Wm. E. Dougherty, Government Deputy Surveyor, in 1859,

Corner - Original corner recovered by J.J. Melendy. Found post and stumps of original birch 10" bears S67°W 98-3/4 links. BT's nearly gone. He set new post from which hemlock 16" bears N11°E 25-3/4 links and

V.M. Maine recovered corner and set 2-1/2" iron pipe. H.C. Lawrence, Registered Land Surveyor, recovered this corner in 1949 during his retracement survey. Found BT's intact but distance to birch differs by 11 links.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered H.C. Lawrence's 4" cedar post, squared and scribed S26, S25, S24, S23. This had rotted off and was lying bes iron pipe. Recovered point of wooden post next to the iron pipe. This had rotted off and was lying beside

Recovered OBT - white birch 18" S62°W 86 links scribed S26 BT, now a 12' stub.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. As iron pipe was in perfect shape, it was painted blue and wooden stake was propped up
