





July 1, 2019: I was unable to locate a monument at the corner point. At the coordinates previously measured by Aero-Metric, I established a temporary point. From this point, I found the record 1.5" diam. iron pipe (tipped and unstable) bearing East, 16.5 ft. I was unable to locate other record accessories. The temporary point also checks corners North and South when compared to the RIPCO survey on OCS Map No. A-429. At the temporary point, I set a 0.8" diam., 24" long iron rod buried 6" beneath the gravel surface. I established accessories as shown below. I set a white vinyl sign post bearing West, 9.5 ft.

The coordinate value shown has been verified by at least one of the following methods: 1) comparison to a previously GPS determined published value; 2) the value is the average of two or more GPS observations at a markedly different time; 3) one or more distances were measured back to the GPS observed corner from temporary GPS observed offset locations.
