



January 5, 1931 - Harry C. Hall, Oneida County Surveyor, map for survey in Section 9, T39N, R4E, filed as C884 and the transcribed notes in Hall Book 1, pages 127 through 136. Hall was unable to recover any remaining evidence of the original corner. He re-established the meander corner based on a double proportionate measurement for the southwest section corner and set a pine post in a sand spit, on line and 2368.0 feet west of the southeast section corner. The corner post was referenced by a spike in a low pine stump bearing S 35°E, 73.9 feet and the NW end of the point bears NW, ±15 feet.

March 16, 2020 - James D. Rein, PLS No. 1234. We were unable to find any physical evidence of Hall's re-established meander corner, the position of which, is now at the lake's edge. I determine the corner is obliterated and restore it based on that Oneida County Grid bearing S88°16'35"W from the corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, shown on that certified survey map by Gregory S. Maines, PLS No. 2729, recorded in Volume 22 CSM, on page 4669. This position is harmonious with my earlier establishment of this section line shown on Wilderness Surveying, Inc., Map No. 92-132S, dated the 17th day of March, 1993, and filed in the County Survey Office as C2537. See plan view for restored corner position and new reference ties.
