



04/02/1975 Northwoods survey notes indicate "Set M.C. 2in I.P. & scribed red top, 8in W. Pine N36°E, 7.9ft" near the easterly shoreline of Squirrel Lake and on line with the meander corner across the lake and the northeast corner of Section 30.

07/17/1975 Inman Engineering of Woodruff, WI shows a 2" dia. iron pipe found on the south line of Section 19 near the easterly shoreline of Squirrel Lake (See OCSM No. B6809).

09/18/2025 I found a 2" dia. iron pipe near the easterly shoreline of Squirrel Lake as well as the bearing tree made by Northwoods Surveyors in 1975. This corner fit well with the location shown on OCSM No. B6809 and other surveys in this area. I replaced the iron pipe with a 3" dia. Oneida County aluminum capped monument stamped to identify the corner and set flush with the ground. I set two iron pipes and made two bearing trees to witness the corner as shown below.
