


December 18, 1934: Hall page 212 notes the following: 20.00 fall about .30 N of orig. 1/4 S. identified by both bearings. marks ok. the NE tree is a cedar leaning E. distance between brngs. meas. 26 lks. (rec. 22) set new post (.13 from the tamarac) new: cedar 9" S19°E, .085.

August 19, 1990: I found and accepted a 4" dia. wood post point below the bog surface. I replaced said post with a 2-1/2" dia. aluminum cap on a 72" long aluminum post stamped as shown below. I found the following witnesses: rotted stump \$59°N, 9.8 feet; cedar (dying) 12" \$17°E, 5.9 feet. I established the following witnesses: set nail in tamarack 7" N19°E, 16.52 feet; set nail in balsam 4" \$35°E, 22.66 feet; set nail in balsam 3" \$17°E, 7.35 feet; set nail in balsam 3" \$25°N, 9.32 feet; set plastic sign post north 1 foot; a large beaver dam bears NE 30 feet more or less.
