



January 29, 1959 - E. F. Kowalke, RLS No. 403, map of survey, 6-B-16, for a survey in the East Half of Section 5, T39N, R6E, filed in the county surveyor's office as B6026, and accompanying field notes in Kowalke Book 19, page 59, shows he set an iron pipe for the south meander corner on a straight line between the southeast and east quarter corner of Section 5, referenced by a Birch 10" N 54°E, 6.3' and a N. Pine 5" S 4 1/2°E, 24.4'

May 11, 2017 - James D. Rein, PLS No. 1234, we set an Oneida County capped 2.4" x 30" long aluminum monument to replace a 1.4" dia. x 27" long iron pipe found in place. Based on published county coordinate data, this monument is positioned within 0.3 feet of a straight line between the controlling corners and has been accepted by all subsequent surveyors, in both Sections 4 and 5, as marking the section line. We made new reference ties to the corner as shion in the plan.

The coordinate value shown has been verified by at least one of the following methods: 1) comparison to a previously GPS determined published value; 2) the value is the average of two or more GPS observations at a markedly different time; 3) one or more distances were measured back to the GPS observed corner from temporary GPS observed offset locations.
