Found and accepted an old 2" dia. iron pipe monament with incapped top 22" above grade at this corner location; I carefully removed the older iron pipe and reset the corner location with a standard 2" dia. by 42" long iron pipe monament with a stamped brass cap 20" above grade, and look the 44" long older monament flat on grade next to new iron pipe monament. I set a standard white poly 'T' corner masker jost 1" North of Lew monament set. All original GLC corner evidence is now obliterated; and based upon record versus current section line measure comparisons, the original EC corner would fall about 12 feet into the Wisconsin Liver from its south or left bank. In 1938, Wisconsin Valley Improvement Company notes the older 2" iron pipe at the Wit MC corner, at 7.72% oheins North of the West 1/4 corner of section 12 and at 6.10% chains South of a wit MC corner monament on the North/right bank of the Wisconsin River; and also new BTs: 9" Pn stump N60°W 0.930 chains and a 8" Pn stump 360°E 0.227 chains, both now of unreliable origin or reference usage. This recovery was completed Decom 1.2, 1997; there were no witnesses.


