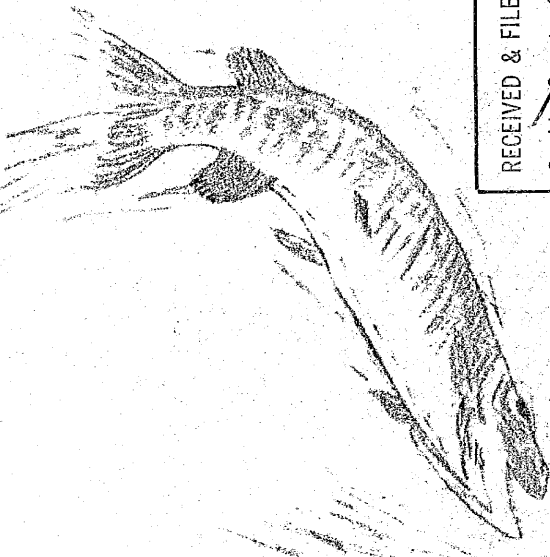


NORTH LINE OF GOV'T. LOT 2

DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land in Government Lot 2 in Section 6 Township 37 North and Range 7 East Oneida County, Wisconsin described as follows:  
Commencing at the Meander Corner on the North line of Gov't Lot 2 on the West shore of Birch Lake marking the Northeast Corner of said Gov't Lot 2; said Corner being marked by a Brasscapped Iron Pipe; thence West along the North line of Gov't Lot 2 a distance of 190 feet; thence South along a North and South base line of the Unrecorded Plat of BIRCH LAKE HILLS a distance of 1100 feet; thence  $S86^{\circ}28'E$  a distance of 200 feet to a Railroad spike in the Center line of a Blacktop Town Road; thence  $N34^{\circ}53'W$  along said center line a distance of 42.6 feet; thence  $N83^{\circ}45'E$  a distance of 49.5 feet to an Iron Pipe marking the PLACE OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; thence again  $N83^{\circ}45'E$  a distance of 239.5 feet to an Iron Pipe; thence  $S85^{\circ}28'E$  a distance of 75.0 feet to an Iron Pipe at the West shore of Birch Lake; thence Northerly along the shore of said lake a distance of 310 feet as measured along the shore of Birch Lake to an Iron Pipe; thence  $S83^{\circ}59'W$  a distance of 294.8 feet to an Iron Pipe on the East side of the above mentioned Town Road; thence  $S47^{\circ}35'E$  a distance of 111.1 feet to an Iron Pipe
