**TAX PARCEL No. LY-732-12 (Map No. 25-104)**

A parcel of land in Government Lot 2 and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 9, Township 37 North, Range 4 East, Town of Lynne, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being tax parcel number LY-732-12, shown on Map No. 25-104, by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated December 26, 2025, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Sections 9 and 10, marked by a capped aluminum monument; thence S 87°11'48"W for a distance of 550.16 feet along the quarter line, to the place of beginning, being at the southwest corner of that parcel of land described in Document Number 721232.

Thence continuing S 87°11'48"W for a distance of 1063.41 feet along the quarter line, to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Willow Lake; thence meandering along the lake, N 01°47'44"E for a distance of 707.38 feet to an iron pipe on the southerly line of that parcel of land described in Document Number 840670; thence N 87°11'48"E for a distance of 1023.62 feet along the southerly line of said parcel of land described in Document Number 840670; thence S 01°25'42"E for a distance of 705.30 feet along the westerly lines of a deed gap and those parcels of land described in Document Number 564118 and Document Number 721232, to the place of beginning.

The above described lateral lot lines extend to the easterly shore of Willow Lake; and includes all those lands lying between the meander line and the ordinary high water mark.
