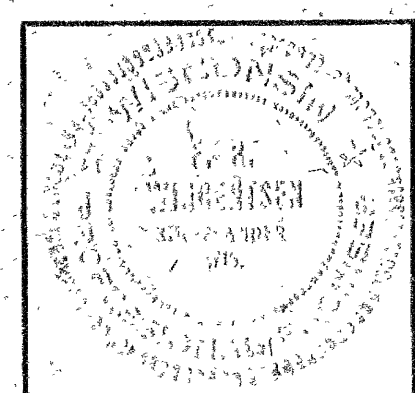
Surveyor's Certificate

We hereby certify that we have surveyed and subdivided the South 1/2 of the NE 1/4 and the South 1/2 of the S.W. 1/4, Sec 16, T.37N, R.7E of the 4th P.M. Oneida County, Wisconsin, also a parcel in Gov't Lot 5, Sec. 16, more particularly described as follows:-
 Parcel No. 1.- Beginning at the Meander Corner (an iron pipe) marking the intersection of the South line of Gov't Lot 5 and the Easterly shore of Little Horsehead Lake and from which a Tamrack tree 8" in diameter bears S. 73° E. 11.55' distant and a Tamrack tree 7" in diameter bears N 26° E. 14.85' distant thence S. 87° 52' E on the South line of Gov't Lot 5 a distance of 300' to an iron pipe; thence N. 2° 08' E. a distance of 100' to an iron pipe, thence N 87° 52' W on a line parallel with the South line of Gov't Lot 5 a distance of 326.7' to an iron pipe on the Easterly shore of Little Horsehead Lake; thence S 19° 26' W on a straight line along said shore line a distance of 74.6' to an iron pipe, thence S. 57° 16' E. on a straight line along said shore line a distance of 572' to the place of beginning.
