A parcel of land in Government Lot 1, Section 17, Township 39 North, Range 5 East, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, being parcel "-A-" shown on Map No. 98-90 by Wilderness Surveying, Inc., dated July 1st, 1998, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Meander Corner where the north line of said Section 17 intersects the westerly shore of Squirrel Lake, marked by a brass capped iron pipe; thence meandering along the lake South 26 degrees 22 minutes 19 seconds East for a distance of 97.76 feet to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe on the northerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 169 Deeds, on page 71.

Thence continuing along the lake South 16 degrees 45 minutes 40 seconds East for a distance of 102.70 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 72 degrees 06 minutes 50 seconds West for a distance of 50.43 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 86 degrees 29 minutes 50 seconds West for a distance of 215.90 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 87 degrees 00 minutes 08 seconds West for a distance of 203.97 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 53 degrees 24 minutes 14 seconds West for a distance of 143.49 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 87 degrees 42 minutes 32 seconds West for a distance of 53.10 feet to an iron pipe on the easterly right of way line of Bo-Di-Lac Drive; thence along said easterly right of way line North 02 degrees 50 minutes 09 seconds East for a distance of 30.12 feet to an iron pipe on the northerly line of that parcel of land described in Volume 169 of Deeds, on page 71; thence North 87 degrees 42 minutes 32 seconds East for a distance of 604.81 feet along the northerly line of said parcel of land described in Volume 169 of Deeds, on page 71 to the place of beginning.
