


MINOCQUA STREET SURVEY

To define certain street lines necessary for the construction of a cement sidewalk as follows:
 The North side of Chicago Ave. beginning at Menomonee St., Easterly, bordering out Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Payne's First Add'l, thence bordering Blocks 1 and 7 of the Hazelhurst Land Co.'s First Add'l, thence diagonally (on an easement provided) thru Lot 2 of Block 3 in "E-wau-na" (from the south line of Block 7 extended), across a vacated part of Hazelhurst Blvd. and a corner of Lot 5, Blk. 3 "E-wau-na", here terminating the sidewalk for Chicago Ave. The East side of St. Germain Street beginning at Chicago Ave., southerly, bordering Blocks 6 and 5 of the Hazelhurst Land Co.'s Add'l as far as Cedar Street.

Surveyor's Certificate

This is to certify that at the request of the Town of Minocqua I have surveyed the above mentioned street lines. Establishment thereof necessitated considerable research owing to adverse conditions in this vicinity. Working from several different established monuments and original lot stakes in widely separated portions, I was enabled to reconstruct Payne's Out Lot and parts of Hazelhurst Land Co.'s Add'l and E-wau-na as shown on the plat herein drawn. Working eastward from the east line of Menomonee St. as defined by the original iron monument for south line Chicago Ave. and the iron at the south line of Front St., I found Out Lots 1 and 2 in close agreement with the recorded plat. Out Lot 3 fails to close but I have held the three initial courses as agreeing best with occupation. I have pro-rated the Chicago Ave. frontage thence to its juncture with St. Germain Street as identified by finding buried irons marking the northwest corner Blk. 6 and the southeast corner Blk. 7 Hazelhurst Land Co.'s Add'l and by stake found at northwest corner Lot 10 Blk. 6 and by iron found at northwest corner Lot 3 Blk. 5 of the same. Detail in Lot 5 Block 3 of E-wau-na determined from stakes found at the west corner of Lot 5, the south corners of Lot 6 Blk. 3 and north corner of Lot 3 Blk. 1.
