

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Stuart L. Foltz, Registered Land Surveyor No. S-1170, hereby certify that, in full compliance with the provisions of the Oneida County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Control Ordinance and the subdivision regulations of the town of Little Rice, and under the direction of Bruce L. Bishop and Patricia A. Bishop, owners of said land, I have surveyed, divided and mapped Killarney Bay Addition 1, that such county plat represents all exterior boundaries and the subdivision of the land surveyed.

A parcel of land in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 23, T36N, R5E, Little Rice Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more

particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Quarter Corner to Sections 14 and 23, marked by a 1-1/2" iron pipe; thence 82°04'56"E, 1154.55 feet along the west line of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 to a 1" iron pipe on the northerly right of way line of Kelly Fire Lane, thence along said right of way line: \$89°32'33"E, 160.80 feet to a 1" iron pipe, and easterly 26,37 feet along the arc of a curve, concave southerly with a radius of 265.45 feet, the chord of which bears \$86°41'48"E, 26.36 feet, to the place of

beginning, marked by a 1" iron pipe. Thence N19°00'00"E, 64.73 feet to a 1" iron pipe, thence northerly 119.25 feet along the arc of a curve, concave westerly with a radius of 401.92 feet, the chord of which bears N10°30'00"E, 118.82 feet, to a 1" iron pipe, thence N2°00'00"E, 330.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe, thence northerly 201.45 feet along the arc of a curve, concave easterly with a radius of 75.00 feet, the chord of which bears N15°03'07"E, 146.12 feet, to a 1" iron pipe, thence N2°18'53"E, 235.57 feet to a 1" iron pipe, thence N45°00'00"E, 80.00 feet to a 1-1/2" iron pipe near the shore of Killarney Lake, thence meandering along Killarney Lake and along the bank of the Little Rice River: S32°18'14"E, 389.66 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S65°16'16"E, 170.87 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S45°42'46" W, 237.81 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S47°33'37"E, 91.70 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S82°15'09"E, 158.44 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S22°12'04"E, 145.82 feet to a 1" iron pipe; S74°59'45"E, 129.39 feet to a 1" iron pipe; S16°12'01"E, 168.64 feet to a 1" iron pipe, S78°41'38"W, 346.24 feet to a 1" iron pipe, and S63°21'10"W, 178.15 feet to a 1" iron pipe on the northerly right of way line of Kelly Fire Lane, thence along said right of way line. northwesterly 83.63 feet along the arc of a curve, concave southwesterly with a radius of 216.15 feet, the chord of which pears N44°56'29"W, 83.11 feet, to a 1" iron pipe, N56°C1'31"W, 151.80 feet to a 1" iron pipe; and northwesterly 128.92 feet along the arc of a curve, concave southwesterly with a radius of 265.45 feet, the chord of which bears N69°56'17"W, 127.65 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of Killarney Lake and the bank of the Little Rice River, and also including a small island lying near the shore of Killarney Lake as shown on this plat.
