

MINOCQUA TOWN BOARD MINUTES Lakeland Times, March 16, 1967 - Section 1 - Page 11

Minutes of the regular town board meeting held March 6, 1967. Present - Ritchie, Foltz, Johnson, Cameron, Bosacki. Art Dorwin appeared before the board requesting permission to move old Rogers farm house to new location behind Dr. Fink. Town Board expressed no objection and Mr. Ritchie will write letter to this effect. Art Dorwin also spoke on Squirrel Hill and possibilities of turning the hill over to town. This has been researched and is apparently alright with Nekossa-Edwards with certain reservations. Mr. Dorwin proposed that the town accept the hill without debt. This will allow prisoner labor among other things. It was suggested by Mr. Dorwin that there would be no cost to the town for operation of the hill. Mr. Foltz suggested that Mr. Dorwin outline his proposal so that board can present the facts to attorney Tinkham. Minutes read and approved as amended. It was suggested that town provide lease to Bob Voyt for triangular parcel of land between his property and Front Street. Motion by Foltz - That town allow 5' set-back from road edge of old Hwy. 51 for the northern most 230 ft. of the Howard Smith property between old and new Highway 51 and 10' set-backs from there on south. Second by Johnson. Treasurer's report by Larry Bosacki. Discussion of snow removal at new post office. Clerk to contact town attorney regarding possible railroad crossing of street in front of new post office and inquire as to steps necessary to obtain this crossing. Accept letter from Ted Hopkins regarding moving of Country Club cottage until official transcript comes through from them. Letter to be placed on file by clerk. Discuss possibility of two-way radio for town crew and chairman. Suggest chairman check prices and possibility of including in budget for next year. Sign and approve vouchers. Approve resolution on Zoning Ordinance No. 18 and 19 to fill out forms and send to zoning chairman. Adourn 10 p.m. William Cameron, Town Clerk

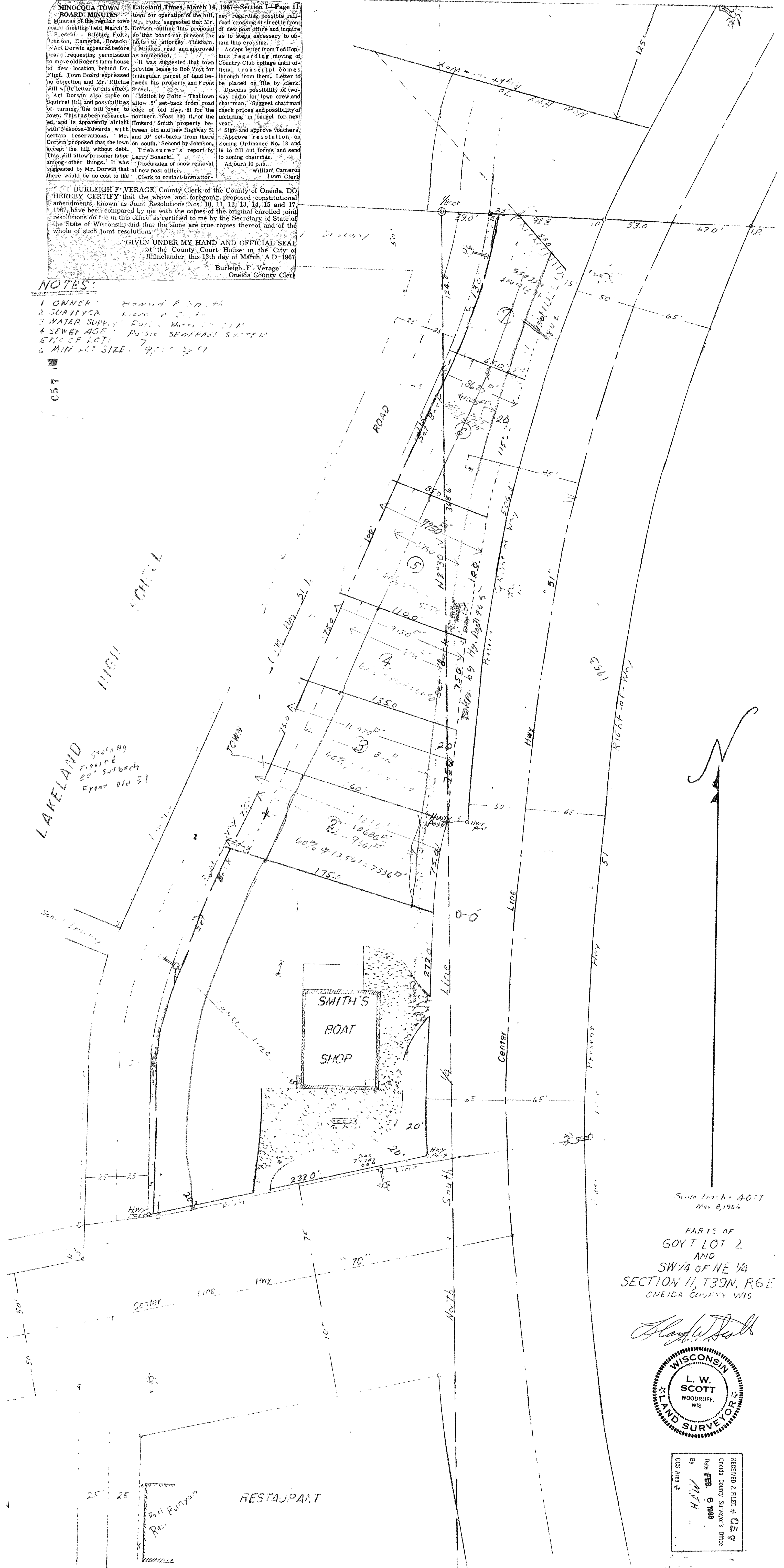

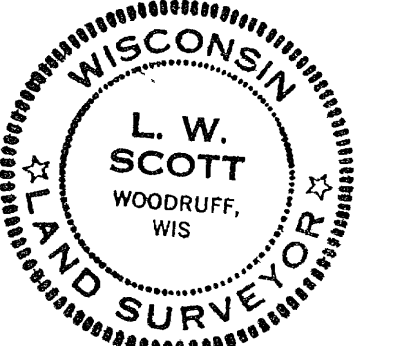
