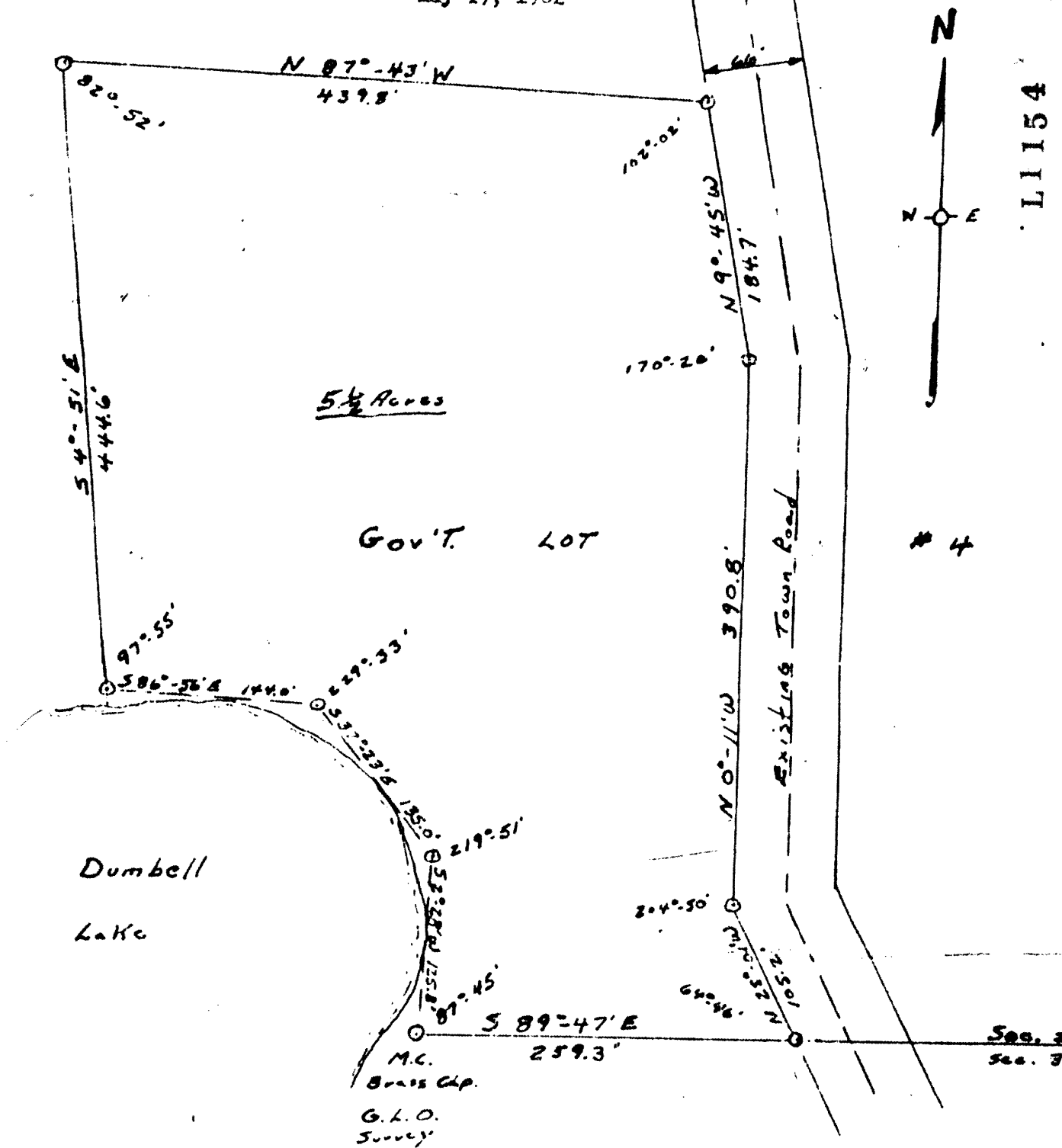


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A parcel of land located in Gov't. Lot #4, Section 28, T37N, R8E, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Meander Corner on the West side of Dumbell Lake (Brass Cap, Gov't. Land Office Survey, 1927) between Sec. 28 & Sec. 33 in the aforementioned Township and Range, said Brass Cap being the POINT OF BEGINNING of the parcel being conveyed, thence S 89°-47' E, 259.3 ft. to an iron pipe on the west boundary of the existing town road, thence N 25°-01' W, 105.2 ft. along the west boundary of said road to an iron pipe, thence N 0°-11' W, 390.8 ft. along the West boundary of said road to an iron pipe, thence N 9°-45' W, 184.7 ft. along the west boundary of said road to an iron pipe, thence N 87°-43' W, 439.8 ft. to an iron pipe, thence S 4°-51' E, 444.6 ft. to an iron pipe (Meander Corner) on the North Shore of Dumbell Lake, thence Southeasterly along the shore of said Lake 404.8 ft. more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
