





SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER ALL IN SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 37 MORTH, RANGE 10 EAST FOR ROBERT SLATTERY TO RECOVER AND MARK THE PROPERTY CORNERS

Description of Corners

- N 1/16 between sections 9 & 10:
 Found ly" iron pipe and 1" iron pipe laying in marsh grass.
 Found rotted Spruce bearing tree stump with scribing N82°W,
 32 feet from ly"pipe as set in the hole it came out of.
 1" iron pipe bears northeast 0.7 feet from ly" pipe.
 I drove both pipe down flush. The iron bar welded across the top of the ly" pipe broke off so I drove a 1" iron pipe, 32"
 long in the center of the ly" pipe and set the bar in the notches on the top of the pipe. I blazed and scribed a W. Birch 5",N37°W, 19.35 ft. and a W. Birch 1/4",West, 26.1/4 ft. and set a 2x/4x32 stake between the pipe and painted the top foot white with red stripes.
- NW 1/16

 Found 4" iron pipe and 1" iron pipe bearing N54°E,0.40 ft. from 4" pipe and Spruce 7",821°W,45.30 feet, scribed and a fallen Balsam 12",885°W,43.0 feet with scribing. I blazed and scribed Tam. 5",N18°E,18.38 ft. and Tam. 5",N33°W, 15.90 ft.
- W 1/14 Found concrete monument with brass cap. See Certificate.
- C-W 1/16
 Found 4" iron pipe and Spruce S30°W, 45.21 ft. and Spruce S3°W, 39.47 ft.
- Found 1" iron pipe and 4" iron pipe laying 6 feet from the 1" pipe. No evidence of either bearing tree found. Found hole for 4" pipe, \$1200, 1.0 feet from 1" pipe. I set 4" pipe in hole and blazed and scribed a Maple 7", \$120E, 19.83 ft. Maple 5", \$840E, 22.12 ft., Balsam 4", \$4000, 5.34 ft. and a Maple 5", \$7000, 11.00 ft.
- S 1/16 between section 9 & 10
 Found 14" iron pipe and Tam.5", N42°W, 59.51 ft. and Tam.3", N64°W, 115.42 ft.
- SW 1/16

 Found 14" iron pipe and W. Birch 6", S32°W, 6.51 ft. and Maple 7". N46°W, 6.00 ft.
- C-S 1/16
 Found iron pipe and Tam.7", S84°W, 40.87 ft. and 3pruce 16", N12°E, 43.94 ft.
- C-S-S 1/64
 Found iron pipe. See drawing number 0-399.
- SW Section Corner Found concrete monument with brass cap set by Hall in 1933.
- W 1/16 Between sections 10 & 15 Found iron pipe and Balsam 7", N76°E, 22.23 ft. and W. Birch l_{\downarrow} ", S78°W, 18.2 l_{\downarrow} ft.
- S 1/4 Found iron pipe with brass cap. See certificate.
