These field notes are a result of a resurvey of T34 N R9E, known as the town of Parrish, Langlade County State of Wisconsin.

All the random lines were run with a transit and corrections offset from random. Measurements were made with a 100 foot steel tape, true lengths being computed and changed to chains and decimals thereof.

This work was done to the best of our ability and according to the requirements of the U.S. M. of I. to surveyors and instructions given by Wisconsin Conservation Department.
