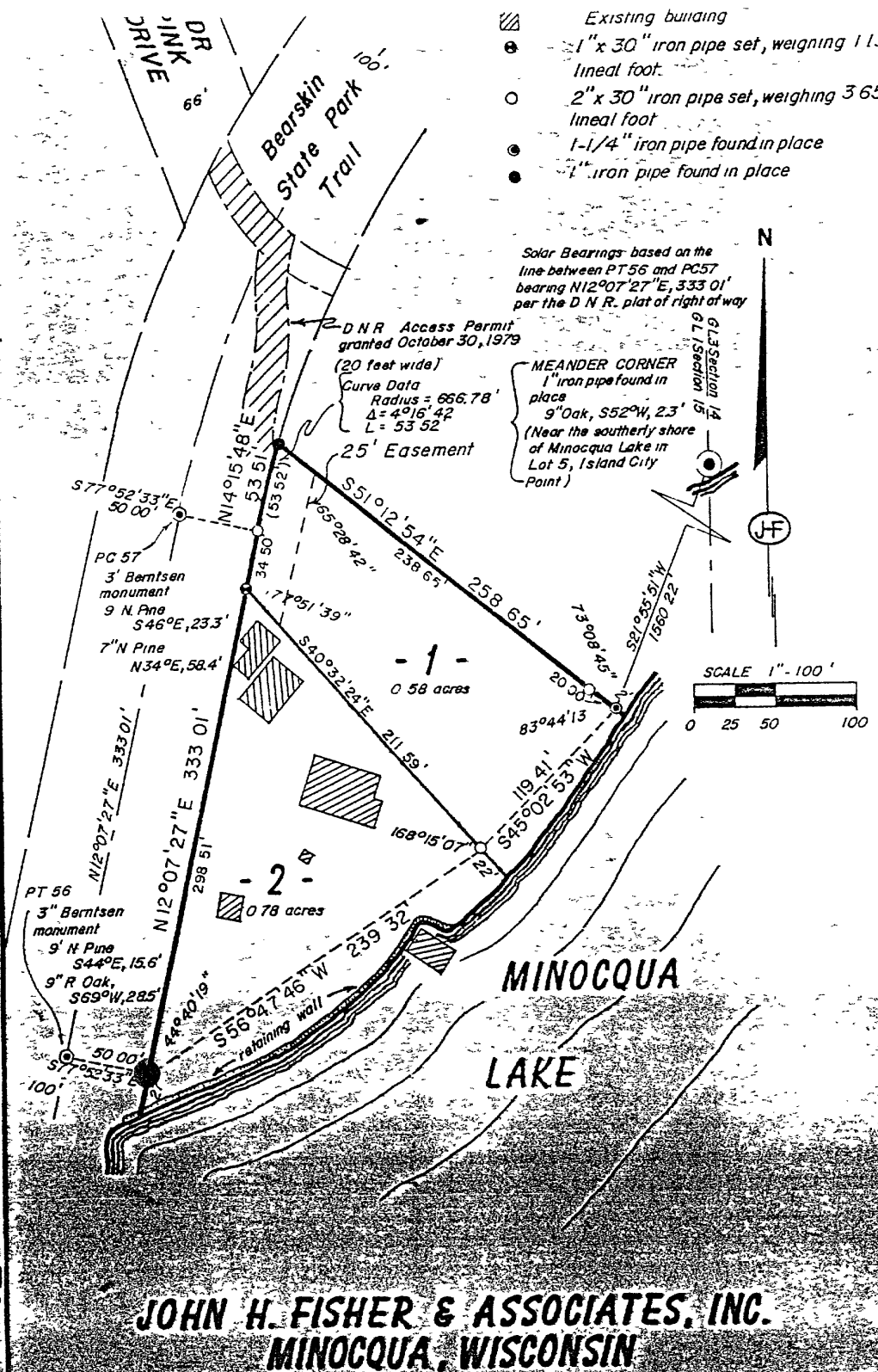

Lots 1 and 2, being part of Gov't. Lot 5, Section 15, T39N, R6E, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southerly most meander corner on the line common to Gov't. Lot 3, Section 14 and Gov't. Lot 1, Section 15, marked by a 1" iron pipe; thence S21°55'51"W, 1560.22 feet to the place of beginning marked by a 1-1/4" iron pipe, near the westerly shore of Minocqua Lake.

Thence meandering the lake S45°02'53"W, 119.41 feet to a 2" iron pipe and S56°47'46"W, 239.32 feet to a 2" iron pipe on the southeasterly right of way line of the Bearskin State Park Trail; thence along said right of way line N12°07'27"E, 333.01 feet to a 1" iron pipe and 53.52 feet along the arc of a curve concave southeasterly, having a radius of 666.78 feet, the chord of which bears N14°15'48"E, 53.51 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence S51°12'54"E, 258.65 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander line and the shore of Minocqua Lake.

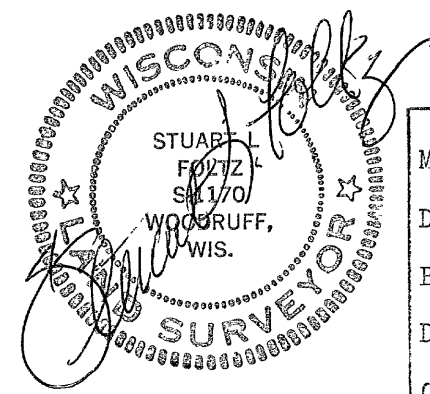
