



MEMORANDUM

THIS PLAT DELINEATES A RETRACEMENT AND REESTAB-LISHMENT OF THE LINES DEFINING LANDS IN SECS. 16 AMD 21, 7.36 N. R. 8 E. AS SHOWN UPON THE TOWNSHIP PLAT AP-PROVED MARCH 18, 1864 IN THEIR TRUE ORIGINAL POSITIONS ACCORDING TO THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE PO-SITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNERS, AND AN EXTENSION SURVEY INCLUDING LANDS IN SECS. 16 AND 21. WHICH WERE ERRONEOUSLY OMITTED FROM THE ORIGINAL SURVEY AND NOT SHOWN ON SAID PLAT.

THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL RECORD MEANDER COURSES OF CRESENT LAKE IN SECS. IS AND 2! IS SHOWN BY AN IRREGULAR LINE WITH NUMBERED AMBLE POINTS. THE MEANDER COURSES AS THUS ORIGINALLY REPORTED WERE GROSSLY IN ERROR AND WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE COURSES FALLING IN THE WATER HAVE THEREFORE BEEN MARKED AS A FIXED BOUNDARY, WITH THE DIRECTIONS AND LENGTHS OF THE SEVERAL COURSES ADJUSTED TO THE RECORD OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY.

THE SURVEY WAS EXECUTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN GENERAL LAND OFFICE LETTER 1754153 E. DATED MAY 9, 1939, WHICH BEAR DEPARTMENTAL APPROVAL UNDER DATE OF MAY 25, 1939.

THE VIRGIN TIMBER ON THE UPLAND IN SEC. IS MAS BEEN CUT AND A GROWTH OF YOUNG POPLAR BIRCH, OAK, MAPLE, AND PINE HAS TAKEN ITS PLACE. MOST OF THE VIRGIN TIMBER IN SEC. 21 IS STILL STANDING AND CONSISTS OF HERIOCK, BIRCH, PINE, MAPLE, POPLAR, AND OAK. THE TIMBER FOUND IN THE SWAMPS IS MOSTLY SPRUCE, TAMARACK, BALSAM, AND SOME CEDAR.
