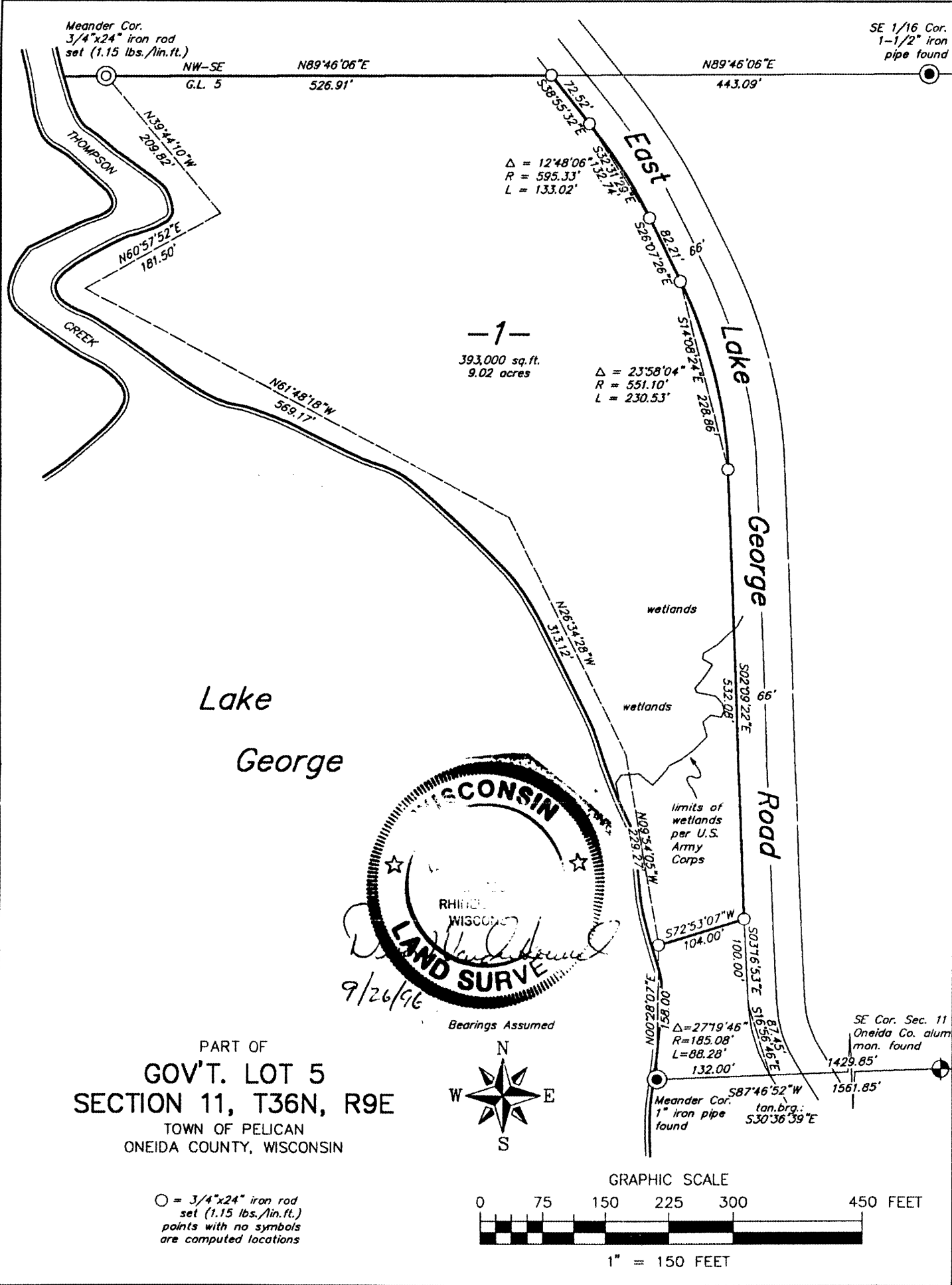

**CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP 1932-A**

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:

I, Devon Vanden Heuvel, Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify that I have surveyed, divided and mapped the following Certified Survey being part of Government Lot 5, Section 11, Township 36 North, Range 9 East, Town of Pelican, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at the meander corner on the Easterly shore of Lake George and on the line common to Sections 11 and 14, marked by a 1" dia. iron pipe; thence N0°28'07"E, 158.00 feet along a meander line of Lake George to the point of beginning, marked by a 3/4" dia. iron rod;

thence meandering along Lake George and Thompson Creek: N9°54'05"W, 229.27 feet; N26°34'28"W, 313.12 feet; N61°48'18"W, 569.17 feet; N60°57'52"E, 181.50 feet and N39°44'10"W, 209.82 feet to a meander corner on the North line of Government Lot 5, marked by a 3/4" dia. iron rod; thence leaving said meander line, N89°46'06"E, 526.91 feet along the North line of Government Lot 5 to a 3/4" dia. iron rod on the Westerly right-of-way line of East Lake George Road; thence S38°55'32"E, 72.52 feet along said right-of-way line to a 3/4" dia. iron rod; thence Southerly, 133.02 feet along said right-of-way line and the arc of a curve, concave Westerly, the central angle of which is 12°48'06", the radius of which is 595.33 feet, the chord of which bears S32°31'29"E, 132.74 feet to a 3/4" dia. iron rod; thence S26°07'26"E, 82.21 feet along said right-of-way line to a 3/4" dia. iron rod; thence Southerly, 230.53 feet along said right-of-way line and the arc of a curve, concave Westerly, the central angle of which is 23°58'04", the radius of which is 551.10 feet, the chord of which bears S14°08'24"E, 228.86 feet to a 3/4" dia. iron rod; thence S2°09'22"E, 532.08 feet along said right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

Said parcel of land contains 9.02 acre more or less and is subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

I further certify that this plat is a correct representation of all exterior boundaries of the land surveyed and the subdivision thereof made; that I have made such survey, land division and plat by the direction of Russel Ruth the owner of said land; that I have fully complied with the provisions of Chapter 236 of the Wisconsin State Statutes and the subdivision regulations of the County and Town in surveying, dividing and mapping the same.
