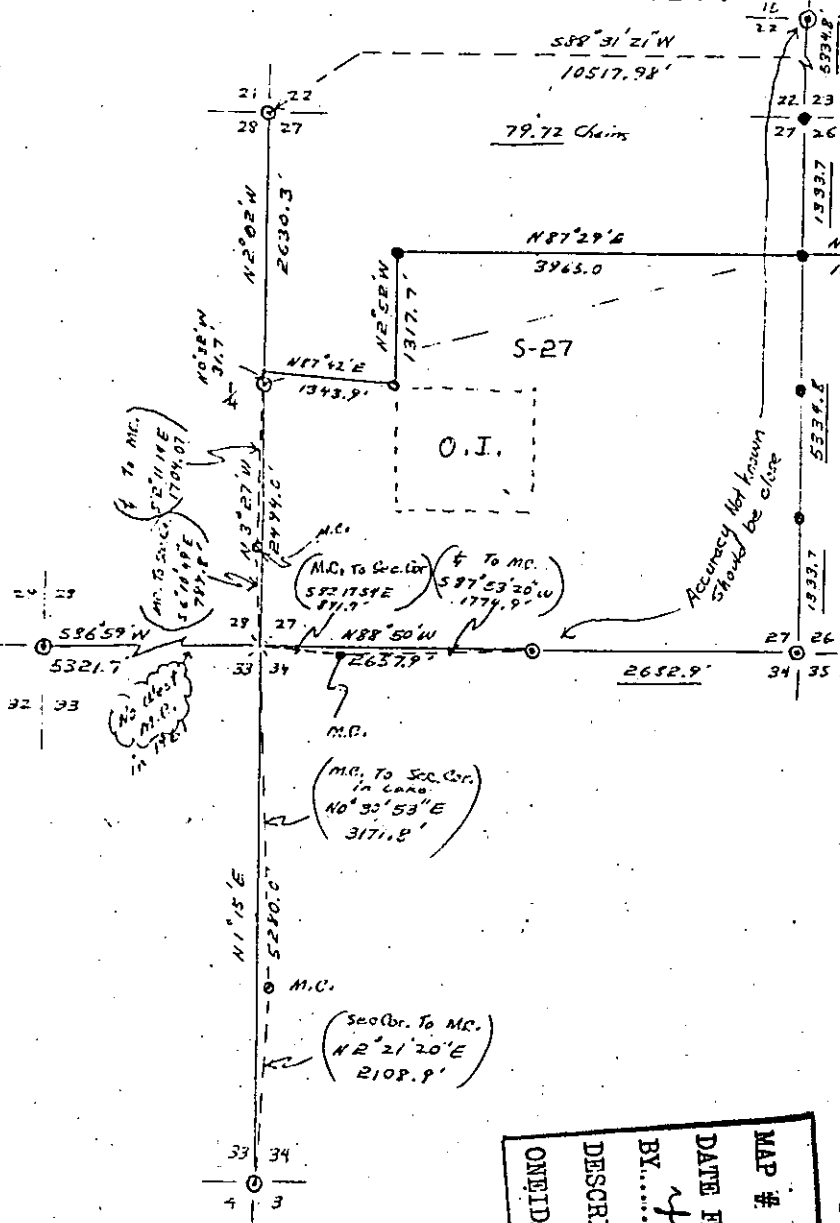

Solid Black Corners and underlined Measurements were done By previous Surveys in 1950's

All other Bearings and Measurements were obtained By Transit & Chain Survey done in 1961.

All circled Corners including M.C.'s were found 1950's except Sec. Cor. 29/28 that was set by Proportioning 196. and Sec. Cor. 21/23 set in 1961, also proportion. No records were ever found on how M.C.'s were established.

Sec. Cor. in lake was not proportioned N. & S. but used as shown for subdividing of Sects. 28 & 33 because of the way properties were previously layed out in Sec. 33 along the west shore of Lake. Northwoods Surveyors assisted in making that decision. I believe it was agreed that properties there were long established on the basis of the East Section Line of sec. 33 being a full mile. The west M.C. was gone at that time.

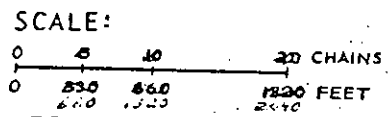
