PARCELS 1, 2 and 3, being part of Gov't. Lot 2, Section 5, T37N, R6E, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:
 Commencing at the meander corner where the north line of section 5 intersects the easterly shore of McCormick Lake, marked by an iron pipe, witnessed by a 10" White Birch bearing S52°W, 6.0 feet; thence S47°-11.4'W, 915.17 feet to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe near the southerly shore of McCormick Lake. Thence S84°-38.0'W, 489.60 feet along the Lake to an iron pipe; thence S3°-31.0'E, 513.30 feet to an iron pipe on the northerly right-of-way line of McCormick Lake; thence along the right-of-way line, S89°-07.0'E, 155.40 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing along the right-of-way line; S89°-34.0'E, 519.60 feet to an iron pipe; thence N21°-12.0'W, 605.50 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of McCormick Lake.
