Description of Parcel

Beginning at a point on the shore of Lake Tomahawk 51.4 feet S 86° W from the one-quarter (1/4) corner between Sections 3 and 4, Township 38 North, Range 7 E, marked as a meander corner by A. J. Lytle in 1947, thence N 86° E for 51.4 feet to the one-quarter (1/4) corner between Sections 3 and 4 set by E. F. Kowalke in 1957; thence N 2° 23' W for 502.8 feet along the Section line between Sections 3 and 4 to a meander corner on the shore of Lake Tomahawk set by E. F. Kowalke in 1957; thence N 83° 06' W for 99.2 feet along the shore of Lake Tomahawk to a meander corner set by A. J. Lytle in 1947; thence S 4° 09' 20" E for 319.8 feet to a meander corner on the shore of Lake Tomahawk set by A. J. Lytle in 1947; thence easterly and southerly along the shore of Lake Tomahawk to the point of beginning, containing .83 acres, more or less.
