AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, uncertainty has hertofore existed as to the location of the southern and eastern boundaries of Government Lot 6, Section 5, T37N, R7E, this agreement is made this day between NATIONAL CONTAINER CORPORATION, owners of the property adjoining Govt. Lot 6, and HARRISON MCNOWN, owner of Govt. Lot 6.

The parties hereto, in consideration of mutual benefits, mutually agree that the boundary line bordering the south and east sides of Govt. Lot 6 is as follows:

From the iron pipe set to be the common corner to sections 5, 6, 7, 8, T37N, R7E, from the original survey notes and rereferenced as follows:

- Edge of Simons Lake approximately 17 ft. due north
- Edge of Simons Lake approximately 10 ft. due west
- 5 in. white pine N. 70°, W. 11.4ft.
- 5 in. norway S. 50°, E. 17.2 ft.
- 13 in. norway S. 50°, W. 20.0 ft.
- Thence north 1'-00' E. 1350 ft to the point of beginning which is the southwest corner of Govt. Lot 6, thence N. 89° 56' E. 1320 ft. to the southeast corner of Govt. Lot 6, thence N. 0'-04' W. 1328 ft. to the northeast corner of Govt. Lot 6.

And the parties agree that the map attached is a correct representation of the division line established.

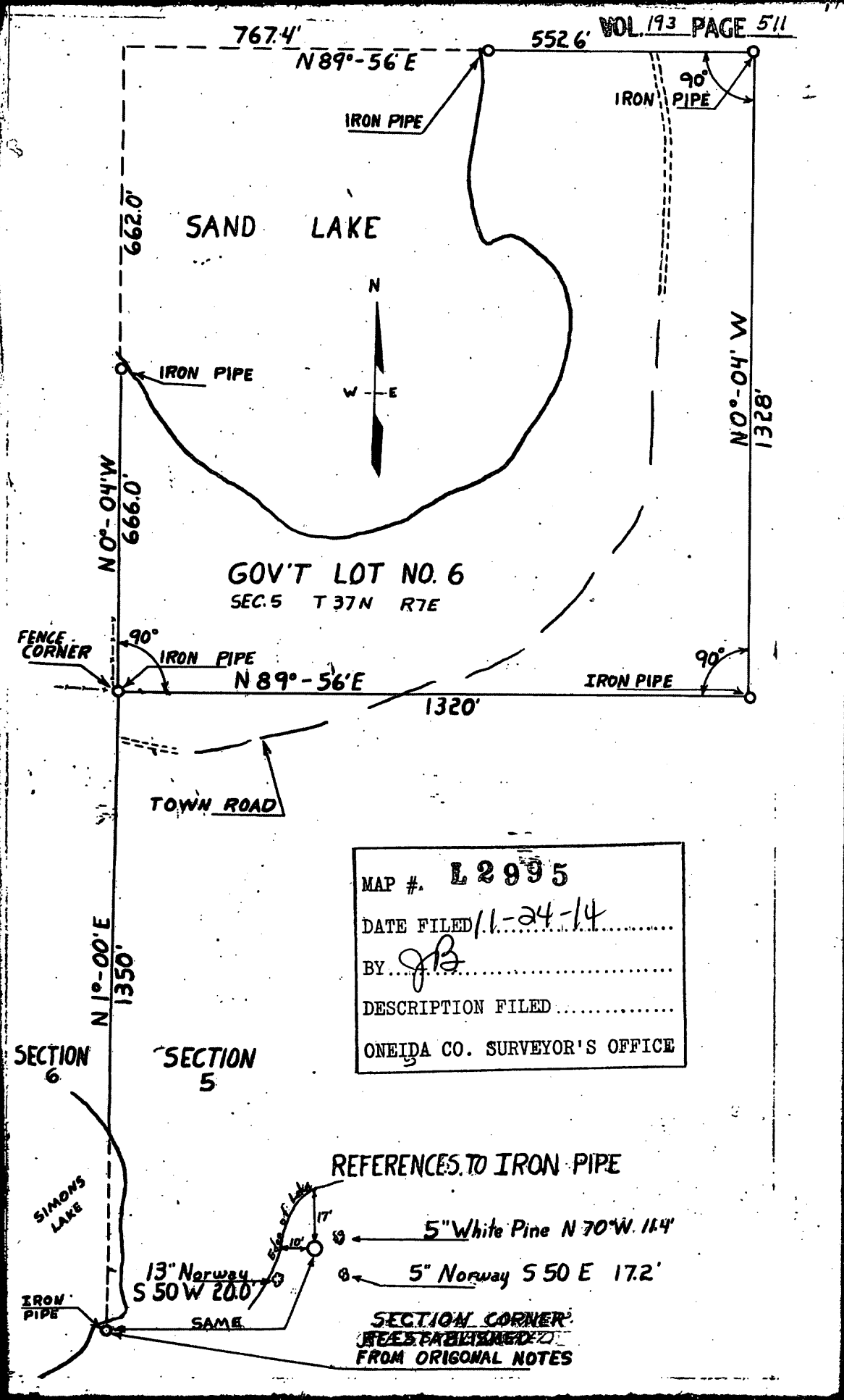
