STIPULATION AND JUDGMENT

JULIUS J. BARRUS, and ALICE A. BARRUS, his wife, and the TOWN OF PELICAN, a municipal subdivision,

Defendants.

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties that the Court may without notice to any party, enter judgment in the following respects:

- 1. The defendants Barkus be required to remove the fence invading the plaintiff's property as said fence is drawn in Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154 and to put the property located thereunder and confined therein in the same condition as it was prior to the erection of said fence.
- 2. That the defendants Barkus be required to remove the garage located on the town road as said garage is drawn in Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154.
- 3. That the defendant township be required to maintain and continue present road to the plaintiff's property according to the recorded plat thereof and as drawn in Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154.
- 4. That judgment be entered in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendants Barkus in the sum of \$188.82.
 - 5. That no costs be awarded to any party.

6. That the description of the plaintiff's property to-wit "all of that part of the replat of Alburleigh's Shores, known as Lot 77 of the original plat of Alburleigh's Shores according to the recording plat thereof is correctly drawn and described in Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154 which drawing is attached to this stipulation and made part thereof.

Upon the foregoing stipulation and the court being otherwise advised in the premises, it is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed:

- 1. That the defendants Barkus remove from the property of the plaintiff a fence as drawn by Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154 which drawing has been attached to the complaint and made a part of same and put the property located thereunder and confined therein in the same condition as it was before the erection of said fence.
- 2. That the defendants Barkus remove from the town road a certain garage which garage is drawn and indicated on Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154 and which drawing has been attached to the complaint and been made a part thereof.

- 3. That the defendant township be required to maintain and continue the present road to the plaintiff's property which road is drawn on Genisot and Associates, Inc.'s drawing number 4154 and attached to the complaint and made part thereof.
- 4. That the description of the plaintiff's property to-wit
 "all of that part of the replat of Alburleigh's Shores, known as Lot 77
 of the original plat of Alburleigh's Shores according to the recording
 plat thereof" is correctly drawn and described in Genisot and Associates,
 Inc.'s drawing number 4154 which drawing is attached to this judgment and
 made part hereof.
- 5. That the plaintiff has judgment against the defendants Barkus in the sum of \$188.82.
