

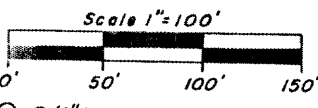

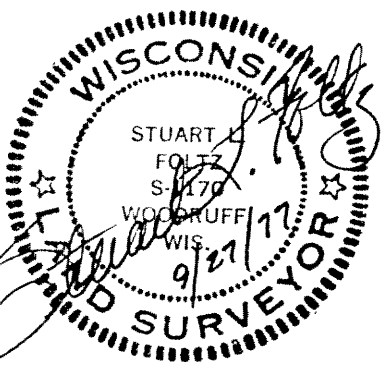
Bearings magnetic

Beginning at the southwest corner of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4, a 1/8th corner; thence N0°15'19"E, 400.85 feet; thence N86°30'11"E, 385.88 feet; thence along Arbutus Lake S18°06'21"E, 105.00 feet; S0°43'46"E, 101.74 feet; S8°10'34"W, 108.00 feet and S33°18'32"E, 105.57 feet; thence leaving the lake S28°51'08"W, 186.22 feet; thence S86°30'58"W, 376.94 feet; thence N0°57'08"E, 157.95 feet to the place of beginning.
