

Survey By R. L. ILG, Land Surveyor,

Compass (SUUNTO) and tape survey of the West Part of Gov't. Lot 3 Sec. 4 T36N R7E on East side of Oneida Lake, Oneida County, Wis., owned by Mareta (Beltz) Marten, Mrs. Lawrence Marten.

Oneida County B.C.I.P. 2" cor. of  $\frac{4}{9} \frac{3}{10}$  Westerly to  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. (about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile on a town road) Bearing approx. S84°W.

A.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. 6"x6" B.C. concrete Post by Hall and Maine in 1937. A recent Maple B.T. is N'ly. This is  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. between Secs. 4 and 9 or S $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of Sec. 4. From this corner an old road grade  $\epsilon$  is N'ly 36 ft. From this  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. N4°W on a line cut by another surveyor (McNown) and presumed to be the N-S  $\frac{1}{4}$  line. Ran N4°W on compass and hit galvanized 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " P. at 995 ft. plus 16 ft. more to the shore of Oneida Lake; 1011 ft. total (a P.K. nail in tree to witness this corner)

B. From the same Concrete Post ( $\frac{1}{4}$  cor.) we ran due west on compass bearing 695' to 5/8" I.P., plus 14 ft. to east shore of Oneida Lake, a total of 709 ft. Northerly of this 5/8" I.P. about 35' is a flattened face, B.T. stump with measuring notch.

No scribes were seen on face. This could be the original b.t. stump by Vernon Maine. Desc. will read due West from  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor.

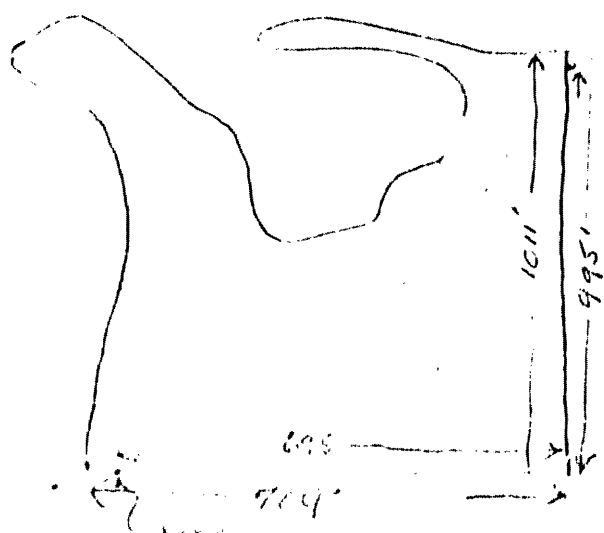
*This is a compass tape survey.
