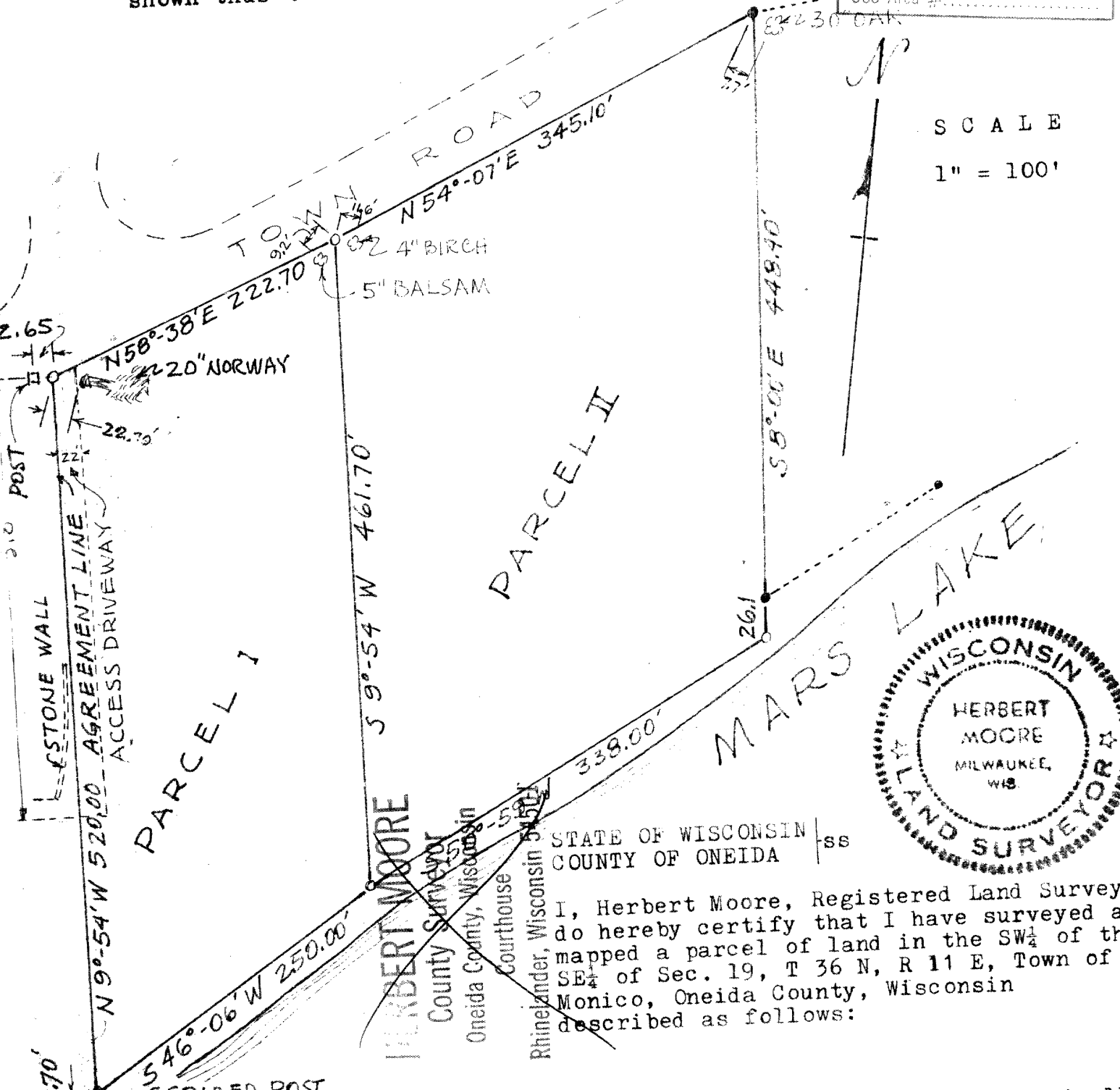


PLAT OF SURVEY OF A PARCEL OF LAND

I, Herbert Moore, Registered Land Surveyor,
 do hereby certify that I have surveyed and
 mapped a parcel of land in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
 SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T 36 N, R 11 E, Town of
 Monico, Oneida County, Wisconsin
 described as follows:

Commencing at a scribed post on the north shore of Mars Lake, originally placed by D.H.Vaughan as the location of the meander corner for the north and south $\frac{1}{4}$ line, which line later became an Agreement Line (see Register of Deeds Vol. 264, Page 456); thence N 9° - 54' W along the said Agreement Line 520.00 feet to a point on the south line of the town road; thence N 58° - 38' E along the south line of the town road 222.70 feet to a point; thence continuing along the south line of the town road N 54° - 07' E 345.10 feet to a point; thence S 8° - 00' E 448.40 feet to a point near the shore of Mars Lake; thence S 50° - 59' W 338.00 feet along the shore to a point; thence S 46° - 06' W along the shore 250.00 feet to the point of beginning, including all land between the easterly and westerly lines to the low water line of Mars Lake.
