

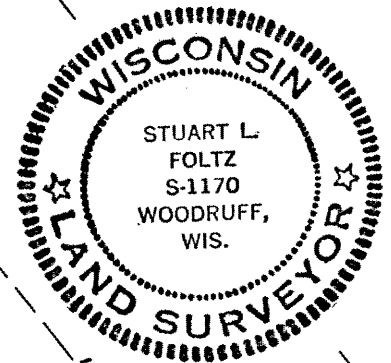

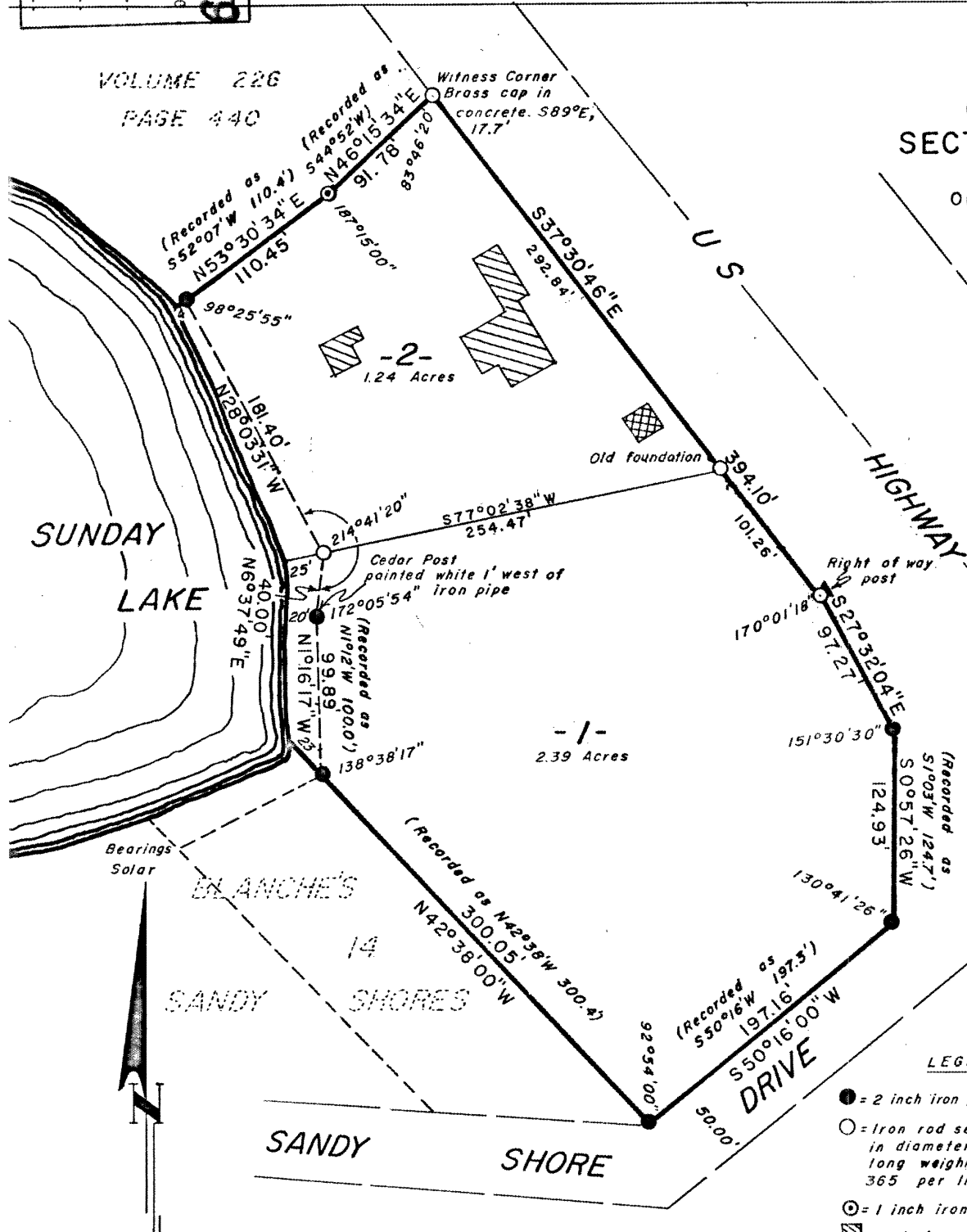

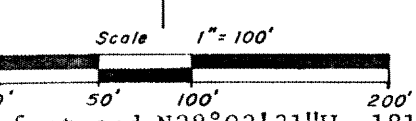

Parcels 1 and 2, being a parcel of land in Gov't Lot 4, Section 3, T39N, R5E, Minocqua Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:



Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 14 in the recorded Plat of Blanche's Sandy Shores near the shore of Sunday Lake; thence along the lake N1°16'17"W, (solar bearings) 99.89 feet; N6°37'49"E, 40.00 feet and N28°03'31"W, 181.40 feet; thence N53°30'34"E, 110.45 feet; thence N46°15'34"E, 91.78 feet; thence S37°30'46"E, 394.10 feet; thence S27°32'04"E, 97.27 feet; thence S0°57'26"W, 124.93 feet; thence S50°16'00"W, 197.16 feet; thence N42°38'00"W, 300.05 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of Sunday Lake.

Subject to any easements, restrictions, and rights of way of record or of use, and to a perpetual easement for public utilities.
