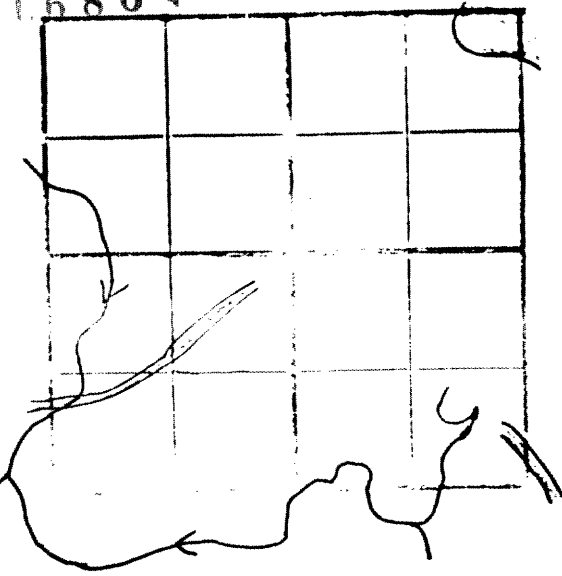

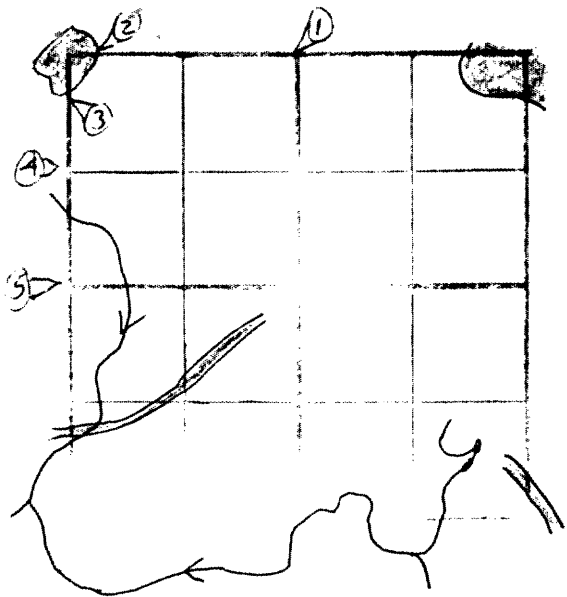

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① N¹/₄ 5 - ~~wood post~~ at NW corner of swamp (W. Wood notes) ¹⁹⁸⁸

found 2" i.p., no cap, and long lower blaze on 5B5" scribing includes 1/4 C, west 27.8' Made BT's Asp 5" N65°W 13.10', OR 4" N50°E 33.00' SB 4' East 13.90' (Seymour 12/1/88)

(in 1977 this was a 4x4 wood post w "SB" BT) and pw stp N64°E 27.8' Looks like maybe Genistot Surveyors may have placed the i.p.

② E.M.C. on pond - should be ~~wood post~~ (W. Wood (1988) notes) ^{3/4" i.p.}

found 12/88 by Seymour Note See Map of BT's SB 4" N84°E 18.1', T 2" S8°W 6.2' Sec. 32, 33 39-8

③ S.M.C. ~~should be wood post with brass cap according to W. Wood~~
