Had he run the line through to the NW section corner he would have found his corners were East and North of where they are supposed to be. He also ran a line west from his North $\frac{1}{16}$. There has been some trespass of Aspen and Pine along the line.

Dorr had 40.06 from the $W \frac{1}{4}$ North to the section corner. I could not find his $\frac{1}{4}$ corner.
