PARCELS 1, 2 and 3, being part of Gov't. Lots 1 and 2, Section 13, T39N, R4E, Oneida County, Wisconsin more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Section Corner common to Sections 7, 12, 13 and 18, marked by a brass-capped iron pipe; thence S0°-05.1'E, 1143.16 feet to an iron pipe; thence S86°-55.2'W, 1894.42 feet to the place of beginning, marked by an iron pipe.

Thence continuing S85°-55.2'W, 586.66 feet to an iron pipe near the easterly shore of Great Bass Lake; thence meandering along the lake, S40°-28.5'W, 59.89 feet; S39°-34.0'W, 99.91 feet and S33°-37.4'W, 99.69 feet to an iron pipe; thence S82°-24.2'E, 430.61 feet to an iron rod on the westerly right-of-way line of Great Bass Lake Road; thence along said westerly right-of-way line, N11°-41.8'E, 145.36 feet and N42°-46.8'E, 195.26 feet to an iron pipe; thence N86°-55.2'E, 72.48 feet to an iron pipe on the easterly right-of-way line of Great Bass Lake Road; thence along said easterly right-of-way line, S7°-14.6'W, 26.69 feet; S42°-46.8'W, 207.19 feet and S11°-41.8'W, 122.27 feet to an iron rod; thence S82°-24.2'E, 257.95 feet to an iron pipe; thence N0°-44.0'W, 336.80 feet to the place of beginning.

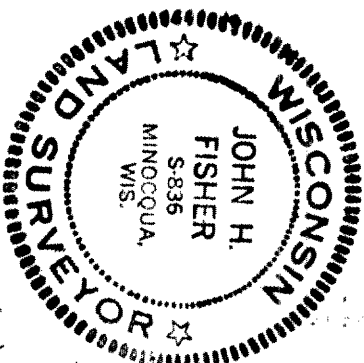
Including also all lands lying between the meander lines and the shore of Great Bass Lake.

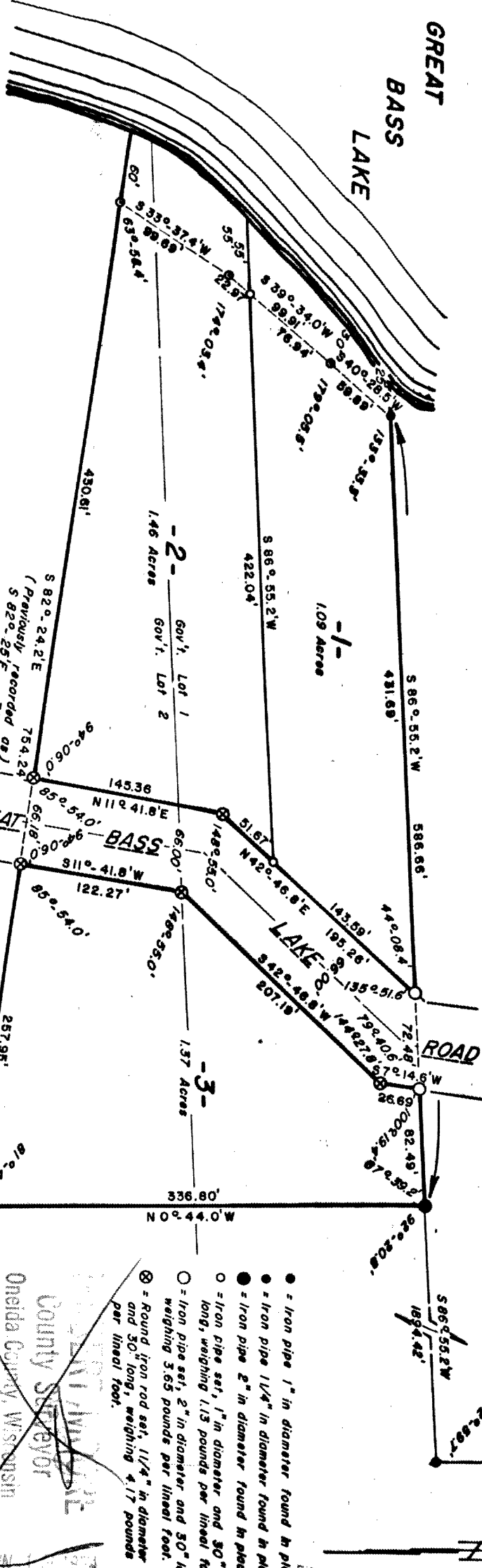
Gov't. Lots 1 & 2
