The large pine has been cut and removed several years ago.

There is a small house 12x16 ft. on West point of island, occupied by a family named Dunn also a garden 40 x 60 feet. Dunn is now engaged in cutting timber to build a larger house and to make other improvements.

Survey executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley Transit in perfect adjustment. Courses Chains. I commenced at corner to Sections 7-8-17 and 18 Thence I run N 85° E on true line between Sections 8 and 17 8.89 Intersect Squirrel Lake at Meander post. I then placed flag on N.E. point of island, flag bears S.332° E. I then chained over the ice to flag 1.30 Intersect Lake. 6.00 Shore line 30 links west. 10.00 Shore line 75 links west. 12.00 Shore line 60 links west shore line runs S. 45° W. 43.61 To island Steep bank 25 feet high. 44.08 Set auxiliary Meander post on top of steep bank. Value of improvements to date \$75.00. Average depth of water in channel on east side of island is 15 feet and average width of channel on east side of island is 20.00 chains

Average depth of water on west side of island is 20 feet and average width of channel on west side of island is 24.00 chains.

There is a dam on lot 2 in section 30 which when closed raises the water about 6 feet in Squirrel Lake. It has just been closed and water is raising. The flowage from this dam has killed the timber on the shores of lake and island, it has fallen, and the shores are covered with dead timber which makes it exceedingly difficult to get through.

Minocqua is the nearest village and is 13 miles by wagon road from Squirrel Lake. Lac Du-Flambeau is 8 miles from Squirrel Lake but there is no road to go there.
