

Commencing at the meander corner on the line common to Sections 9 and 10, marked by a 1" iron rod on the northeasterly shore of Upper Kaubashine Lake; thence N38°51'00"E, 22.20 feet to the place of beginning, marked by a 4" X 4" concrete monument.

Thence along the meander line N31°26'55"W, 204.16 feet; N3°04'49"E, 101.35 feet; N59°08'42"W, 201.75 feet and S51°11'01"W, 206.03 feet; thence N3°33'09"W, 221.64 feet to a 4" iron pipe; thence N68°20'42"E, 419.98 feet to a 1" iron pipe on the southwesterly right of way line of East Kaubashine Road; thence along said right of way line S0°04'48"W, 203.46 feet to a 1" iron pipe and S39°52'21"E, 316.71 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence S38°51'00"W, 230.36 feet to the place of beginning.

Including also all lands lying between the meander line and the shore of Upper Kaubashine Lake.
