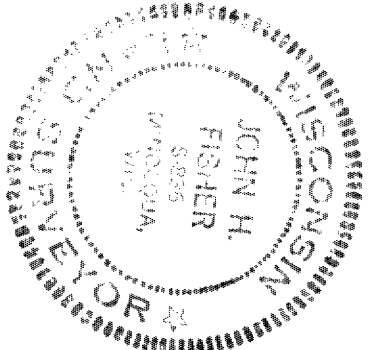

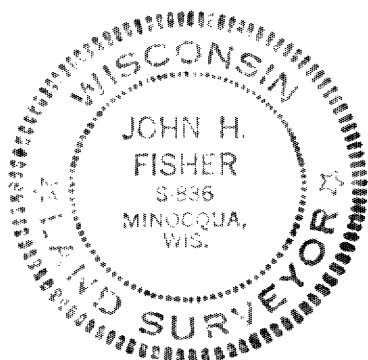
Parcels 1, 2, and 3 being part of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 18, T38N, R8E, Newbold Township, Oneida County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one quarter corner common to Sections 7 and 18, marked by a 2" iron pipe in the centerline of River Road, witnessed by an 8" Oak bearing N78°W, 52.7 feet and a 6" Jack Pine bearing S55°E, 25.7 feet; thence S88°43'06"E, 33.05 feet along the section line common to Sections 7 and 18 to a 2" iron pipe on the easterly right of way of River Road; thence S4°25'34"W, 66.10 feet along said right of way to the place of beginning, marked by a 2" iron pipe.

Thence continuing S4°25'34"W, 285.00 feet along said right of way to a 1" iron pipe; thence S78°47'27"E, 351.01 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence S50°49'15"E, 630.7 feet to a 1" iron pipe; thence N35°55'18"E, 220.00 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence N36°03'00"W, 656.01 feet to a 1" iron pipe on the arc of a cul-de-sac of a private road; thence 83.78 feet along the arc of said cul-de-sac concave, northerly having a radius of 50.00 feet, the chord of which bears N65°22'52"W, 74.31 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence N88°43'06"W, 486.25 feet along the southerly right of way of said private road to the place of beginning.

Subject to any easements, restrictions or reservations of record or of use and to a perpetual easement for public utilities.
