November 28th 1931 Bare ground

H.C. Hall, Ray, Marshall

Look over W-34.

SW x is presumably in $\frac{1}{2}$ N + S road - D.H.V.
made no new bearings. Can
replace this by producing Dorr's $\frac{1}{2}$ 34.

W $\frac{1}{4}$ 34 hard to identify positively.

N $\frac{1}{2}$ W - D.H.V. stump (SE of x) evidently in field.

Orig NW cor. 34. H.C.H. finds this corner.

In N $\frac{1}{2}$ edge of swamp. D.H.V. post down
& charred. His cedar checks. Also a
marked stake for orig. Spruce 17 lbs
Remains of tamarac are there dist from
post a little short. Drive large scribed
pine post - Nothing near for bearings.

Meas. N. thru brush $N 5^\circ E$.

22.52 Cannot find Dorr's Balsam

38.86 Lake shore just W of MC BT.

Both stumps in edge of water. Scribe
marks gone but locations check &
bearings are apparent. MC falls
about 2' in lake.

New line } W. Pine stump 24"
S. $40^\circ E$ 28
pocket compass

Look for Dorr's $\frac{1}{8}$ W of Center but no luck.

" " " $\frac{1}{16}$ in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ " "

Nov. 30th '31 Same party - Snowing.

Identify Orig location SE cor 34 by
pronounced angle in N + S town road & by
fences E + W. Bearings all gone.

Course W. following wire fence.

at E $\frac{1}{8}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ find faced cedar down checking
OK with fence cor. E - W - S.

at Orig. S $\frac{1}{4}$ find Dorr's post in fence line.

checks OK with both ^{sw} stumps. Marks on ^{orig} one.

at W $\frac{1}{8}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ Identify Dorr's $\frac{1}{2}$ by down pine &
hole in ground. $13\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. S of fence
Drive pitch hub at corner & cedar stake
marked BT where line stood.

Tally runs out about $\frac{1}{2}$ town road for SW x 34.

Follows fence E from approx. loc W $\frac{1}{4}$ + find
Dorr's Center. His old post in fence corner (4 way)
at SW corner small, old, field. Maple roots OK.
follow N along fence ($N 5^\circ \pm$) + continue beyond
end of fence. Cannot find Dorr's N $\frac{1}{4}$.

(" turns W near $\frac{1}{8}$ N of C.)

December 3rd 1931 No snow - Fair

Ray + Marshall Hall.

Check E 4 34 by DKV stump.

" comes in N+S road near E edge.

DKV's Hemlock stp. now in pieces. moved.

There is a pine stp. with old govt BT possibly 15 lbs N.E. of cor. but faces S.

No mention of this in Govt. notes or in Darrs.

Meas. N on about 12° E var. parallel fence:

17.60 ± find old post a few lbs SW of Davis B.T. but have no note for it.

35.10 ± DKV post for orig Cor 26-27-34-35 checks OK with his bearings. N.E. one in good condition. S one burned. This corner is on top of hill about 3 rods N of S. shoulder.

Meas. N. from here 39.70 ch. Scaled from map prepared from Davis notes.

fail to find orig. E 4 27 on N 8 on E 27.

Guess at dist. across creek bottom.

Strike new E+W. random just beyond Davis

record dist + find orig corner, possibly 10 or 12 rods E of swamp. Both bearings good but no scribble marks

Drove new pitch post

W.P. stp. 12° S 2° W .66

" - stp 8° N 22½° E .23½

10½ N. random - Remains of old post lying at cor.

Sec. 36 - 36 - 6

Establish N+S ¼ line (N of Centre)

for G.B. Westbrook + W.H. Knuth - Bradley Wis

December 14th 1931 Foggy to fair 10° to 20°

also Gordon Westbrook + J. Bailey?

Produce ha Smiths random as close as possible into Town Road on 4036. Thence (from which point we previously had meas. to N.E. 80.15 ch) \angle E to N 88°-54' to NW x 36 2.623 ch.

NW x identified by intersecting 97 lbs from Lytle's + Pine BT with his random H.

This point comes in E cut, near E of grading + checks OK with a stump N.E., 37 lbs.

Drove 1" x 36" Iron Pipe 6" below road surface
N 3° E new + Pine stp. 14" S 42° E .596 (39)
Ad Lytle's } " tree N 47°-10' E .97
(= 64')

Run E on random from NW cor. by angle

Sto E 89°-13'

0.0 NW cor 36

2.00 3 hub

var. here 1°-23' E.
