bearings he marked here, but since he habitually
used a regular sequence in noting his bearings

i.e. NW NE SE SW

we have for N^o 4 "Hem. 9" SW -16N^o 4 being only thing to be found we swing arc
of 16 lbs in find old post hole facing the
"BT" + in same genl direction as existing post 163° E.

Existing post meas. .20 1/2 from BT stp.

Pile rocks around our post + mark:
