H.C. Hall finds Orig. M.C. #39 on S. shore M^cCord L.
between Secs. 15 & 16. A good boxing on stump
of 10" W. Pine at waters edge. The birch must
have caved off.

This M.C. comes on sloping face of boulder.

Drive pitch post as near the point as possible
but it is about 10" E of where it belongs.

Cruise S. around bay etc & find Orig. M.C. #40

The stump of the 20" W. Pine bears no figures
but the upper & lower facings, partly overgrown
& burned, are plain.

The 9" Birch called for is represented by a
clump of 2nd growth.

This corner comes just north of peak of ridge
± 50' or more north of where Sec. line should
intersect Brown Lake.

Note - Brown & M^cCord Lakes are distinct bodies
of water altho represented as one lake by
Govt. notes & plat. It is common knowledge
with cruisers in this locality and E.S. Shepard's
maps show the two lakes.
When B.F. Dorr subdivided 16 in 1894 he
did very little on the line between 15 & 16
apparently, by his notes available today.

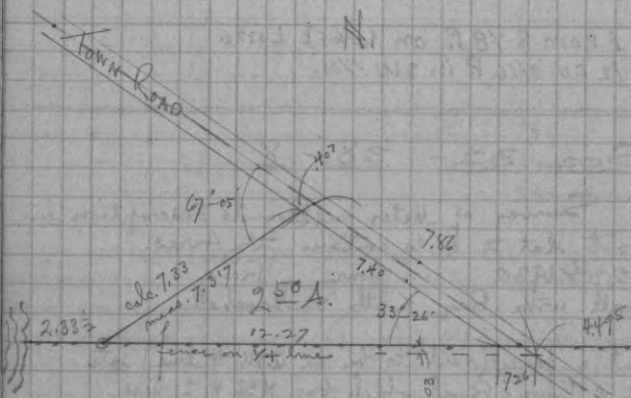
