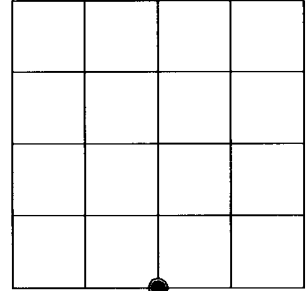

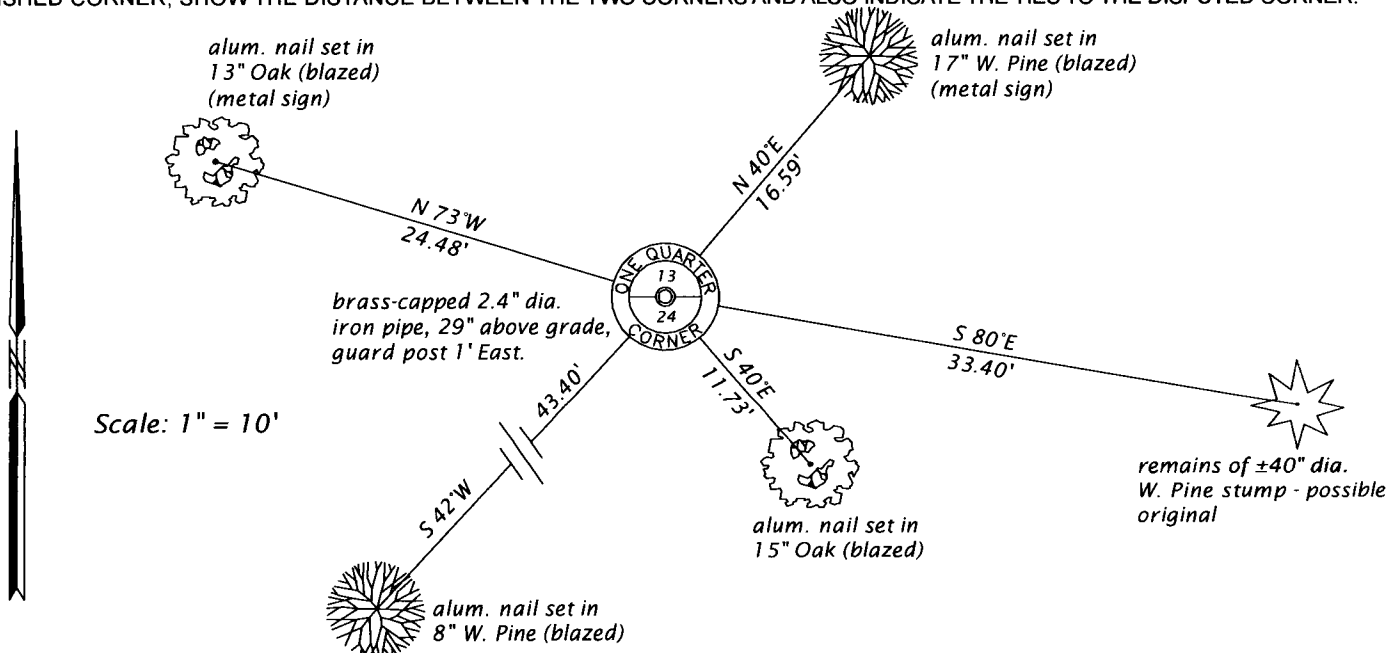

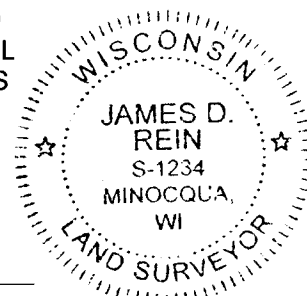
May 2, 2017 - James D. Rein, PLS No. 1234, we recovered brass capped 2.4" dia. iron pipe, referenced by remains of a 40" dia. pine stump harmonious with GLO record. I accept the existing monument as a perpetuation of the original corner and we made new reference ties as shown in the plan.

~~The coordinate value shown has been verified by at least one of the following methods: 1) comparison to a previously GPS determined published value; 2) the value is the average of two or more GPS observations at a markedly different time; 3) one or more distances were measured back to the GPS observed corner from temporary GPS observed offset locations.~~ *gdmqr*
