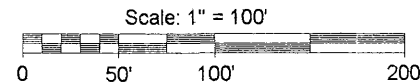

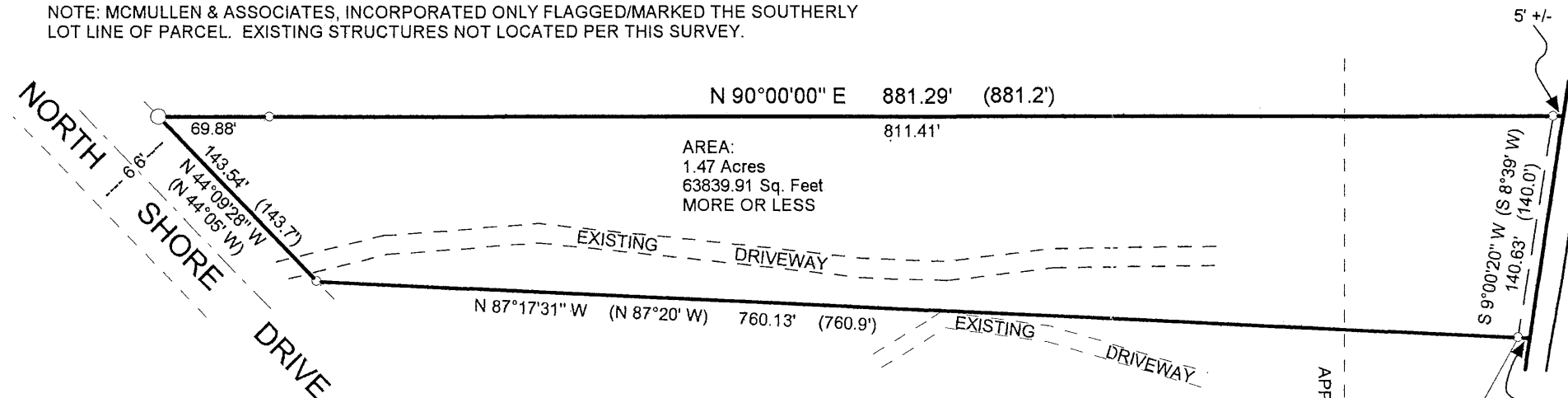
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

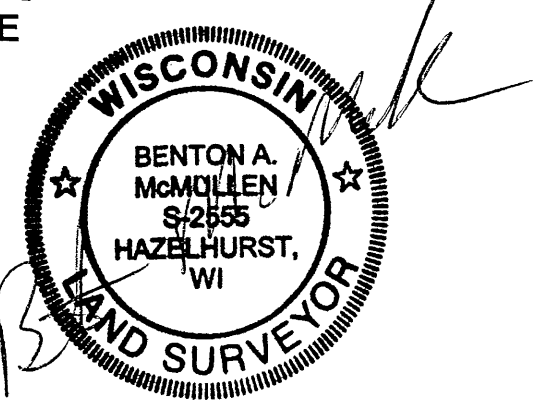

DESCRIPTION

Part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4, Section 18, Township 38 North, Range 8 East, and and Part of Government Lot 7, Section 17, Township 38 North, Range 8 East, town of Newbold, Oneida County, Wisconsin more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of Section 18 marked by an Oneida County Aluminum Monuments found in Place; thence North 28° 38' 49" East (ASSUMED), a distance of 228.63 feet to a found 1" iron pipe near the westerly shore of Two Sisters Lake, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

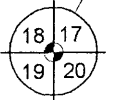
Thence leaving said lake shore North 87° 17' 31" West, a distance of 760.13 feet to a found 1" iron pipe on the easterly right-of-way of North Shore Drive; thence along said right-of-way North 44° 09' 28" West, a distance of 143.54 feet to a found 2" iron pipe; thence leaving said right-of-way North 90° 00' 00" East, a distance of 881.29 feet to a found 1" iron pipe near said lake shore; thence meandering along said lake shore South 9° 00' 20" West, a distance of 140.63 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Said described tract containing 1.47 acres (63839.91 square feet), more or less.

Subject to any easements, restrictions, or rights of way of record or of use.

Including all those lands lying between the above described meander line and the water's edge of Two Sisters Lake.
